- You are my witnesses, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, even my servant whom I **have** chosen, in order, that you may know and **have** faith in me, and that you may understand that I am the same One. Before me there was no God formed, and after me there continued to be none. (**Isaiah 43:10**)
- Even to one's old age I am the same One, and to one's gray-headedness I myself shall keep bearing up. I myself shall certainly act, that I myself may carry and that I myself may bear up and furnish escape. (**Isaiah 46:4**)
- Every good gift and every perfect present is from above, for it **comes** down from the Father of the celestial lights, and with him there is not a variation of the turning of the shadow. (**James 1:17**)
- He has remembered his covenant even to time indefinite, the word that he commanded, to a thousand generations. (**Psalms 105:8**)
- It is the acts of loving-kindness of **Yehowah** that we **have** not **come** to our **finish**, because his mercies will certainly not **come** to an end. (**Lamentations 3:22**)
- For the gifts and the calling of God are not things he will regret. (**Romans 11:29**)
- And you must keep my statutes and my judicial decisions, which if a man will do, he must also live by means of them. I am **Yehowah**. (**Leviticus 18:5**)
- Look! I **have** been taken to bless, and He has blessed, and I shall not reverse it. (**Numbers 23:20**)

- Then Yehowah's angel went up from Gilgal to Bochim and said; I proceeded to bring **YOU** up out of Egypt and to bring **YOU** into the land about which I swore to **YOUR** forefathers. Furthermore, I said; Never shall I break my covenant with **YOU**. (**Judges 2:1**)
- I shall not profane my covenant, and the expression out of my lips I shall not change. (**Psalms 89:34**)
- But you are the same, and your own years will not be completed. (**Psalms 102:27**)
- I shall not express my burning anger. I shall not bring Ephraim to ruin again, for I am God and not man, the Holy One in the midst of you, and I shall not **come** in excitement. (**Hosea 11:9**)
- In this manner God, when he purposed to demonstrate more abundantly to the heirs of the promise the unchangeableness of his counsel, stepped in with an oath. (**Hebrews 6:17**)
