- 1 Corinthians 10:5... Nevertheless, on most of them God did not express his approval, for they were laid low in the wilderness.

[12] - References

- Because of Yehowah's not being able to bring this people into the land about which he swore to them he proceeded to slaughter them in the wilderness. (Numbers 14:16)
- And I myself also lifted up my hand in an oath to them in the wilderness, not to bring them into the land that I had given, one flowing with milk and honey, it is the decoration of all the lands. (Ezekiel 20:15)
- I desire to remind you, despite your knowing all things once for all time, that Yehowah, although he saved a people out of the land of Egypt, afterwards destroyed those not showing faith. (Jude 1:5)
- In this wilderness YOUR carcasses will fall, yes, all YOUR registered ones of all YOUR number from twenty years old upward, YOU who have murmured against me. (Numbers 14:29)
- Moreover, with whom did God become disgusted for forty years?
 Was it not with those who sinned, whose carcasses fell in the wilderness? (Hebrews 3:17)
- But the carcasses of you yourselves will fall in this wilderness.
 (Numbers 14:32)
- But among these there did not prove to be a man of those registered by Moses and Aaron the priest when they registered the sons of Israel in the wilderness of Sinai. (Numbers 26:64)
- So Yehowah's anger blazed against Israel and he made them wander about in the wilderness forty years, until all the generation that was doing evil in the eyes of Yehowah came to their end. (Numbers 32:13)

- Not one among these men of this evil generation will see the good land that I swore to give to YOUR fathers. (Deuteronomy 1:35)
- And the hand of Yehowah also proved to be upon them to disquiet them out of the midst of the camp, until they came to their end. (Deuteronomy 2:15)
- And this was the reason why Joshua did the circumcising; all the people that came out of Egypt, the males, all the men of war, had died in the wilderness on the road when they were coming out of Egypt. (Joshua 5:4)
- That was why Yehowah heard and began to be furious, and fire itself was kindled against Jacob, and anger also ascended against Israel. (Psalms 78:21)
