- **You** heard that I said to **you**, I am going away and I am coming back to **you**. If **you** loved me, **you** would rejoice that I am going my way to the Father, because the Father is greater than I am. **(John 14:28)**
- Jesus said to him; Why do you call me good? Nobody is good, except one, God. **(Mark 10:18)**

- Who is a God like you, one pardoning error and passing over transgression of the remnant of his inheritance? He will certainly not hold onto his anger forever, for he is delighting in loving-kindness. **(Micah 7:18)**
