- And the neighbors and her relatives heard that Yehowah had magnified his mercy to her, and they began to rejoice with her. (**Luke 1:58**)
- And the women began to say to Naomi; Blessed be Yehowah, who has not let a repurchaser fail for you today, that his name may be proclaimed in Israel. (**Ruth 4:14**)
- And all the people of the land were weeping with a loud voice, and all the people were crossing over, and the king was standing by the torrent valley of Kidron, and all the people were crossing over upon the open road to the wilderness. (**2 Samuel 15:23**)
- And David was going up by the ascent of the Olives, weeping as he went up, with his head covered, and he was walking barefoot, and all the people that were with him covered each one his head, and they went up weeping as they went up. (**2 Samuel 15:30**)
- I myself also could well speak as YOU men do. If only YOUR souls existed where my soul is, would I be brilliant in words against YOU, and would I wag my head against you? (**Job 16:4**)
- Certainly I have wept for the one having a hard day, my soul has grieved for the poor one. (**Job 30:25**)
- And there kept coming to him all his brothers and all his sisters and all those formerly knowing him, and they began to eat bread with him in his house and to sympathize with him and to comfort him over all the calamity that Yehowah had let come upon him, and they proceeded each one to give him a piece of money and each one a gold ring. (**Job 42:11**)

- Let those cry out joyfully and **rejoice** who are delighting in my righteousness, and let them say constantly; Let Yehowah be magnified, who takes delight in the peace of his servant. (**Psalms 35:27**)
- He that is holding the one of little means in derision has reproached his Maker. He that is joyful at another's disaster will not be free from punishment. (**Proverbs 17:5**)
- A time to **weep** and a time to laugh, a time to wail and a time to skip about. (**Ecclesiastes 3:4**)
- And when he gets home he calls his friends and his neighbors together, saying to them; Rejoice with me, because I have found my sheep that was lost. (**Luke 15:6**)
- Jesus gave way to tears. (**John 11:35**)
- And if one member suffers, all the other members suffer with it, or if a member is glorified, all the other members **rejoice** with it. (**1 Corinthians 12:26**)
