- But a physical man does not receive the **things** of the spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot get to **know** them, because they are examined spiritually. (**1 Corinthians 2:14**)
- These are the ones that make separations, animalistic men, not having spirituality. (**Jude 1:19**)
- But these men, like **unreasoning animals** born **naturally** to be caught and destroyed, will, in the **things** of which they are ignorant and speak **abusively**, even suffer destruction in their own course of destruction. (**2 Peter 2:12**)
- Therefore God, in keeping with the desires of their hearts, gave them up to uncleanness, that their bodies might be dishonored among them. (**Romans 1:24**)
- Because he who is sowing with a view to his flesh will reap corruption from his flesh, but he who is sowing with a view to the spirit will reap everlasting life from the spirit. (**Galatians 6:8**)
- That **YOU** should put away the old personality which conforms to **YOUR** former course of conduct and which is being corrupted according to his deceptive desires. (**Ephesians 4:22**)
- Then he said; Please, my brothers, do not act badly. (**Genesis 19:7**)

- **And likewise even the males left the natural use of the female and became violently inflamed in their lust toward one another, males with males, working what is obscene and receiving in themselves the full recompense, which was due for their error. (Romans 1:27)**
- **Violent disputes about trifles on the part of men corrupted in mind and despoiled of the truth, thinking that godly devotion is a means of gain. (1 Timothy 6:5)**
- **He that is doing unrighteousness, let him do unrighteousness still, and let the filthy one be made filthy still, but let the righteous one do righteousness still, and let the holy one be made holy still. (Revelation 22:11)**
