

UZZAH PUT TO DEATH FOR TOUCHING ARK OF COVENANT

~ **Yehowah** ... **Action** ... **Uzzah** - Touched the Ark of the Covenant and put to death for his irreverent act. (2 Samuel 6:7) ^[11] - References

2 Samuel 6:7.. At that Yehowah's anger blazed against Uzzah and the true God struck him down there for the irreverent act, so that he died there close by the ark of the true God.

- And Yehowah's **anger** got to be hot **against** them, and he went his way. (**Numbers 12:9**)
- For on account of the **anger** of Yehowah it took place in Jerusalem and in Judah, until he had cast them out of his sight. And Zedekiah began to rebel **against** the king of Babylon. (**2 Kings 24:20**)
- At this a fire came out from before Yehowah and consumed them, so that they **died** before Yehowah. (**Leviticus 10:2**)
- And he went striking **down** the men of Beth-shemesh, because they had looked upon the **ark** of Yehowah. So he **struck down** among the people seventy men, fifty thousand men, and the people began mourning because Yehowah had **struck down** the people with a great slaughter. (**1 Samuel 6:19**)
- At that Yehowah's **anger blazed against Uzzah**, so that he **struck him down** because he had thrust his hand out upon the Ark, and he **died** there before **God**. (**1 Chronicles 13:10**)
- But Er, Judah's firstborn, proved to be bad in the eyes of Yehowah, hence Yehowah put him to death. (**Genesis 38:7**)
- And you must set bounds for the people round about, saying; Guard yourselves **against** going up into the mountain, and do not touch the edge of it. Anybody touching the mountain will positively be put to death. (**Exodus 19:12**)
- After that about ten days elapsed and then Yehowah **struck** Nabal, so that he **died**. (**1 Samuel 25:38**)
- And he got on his way. Later a lion found him on the road and put him to death, and his dead body came to be thrown onto the road.

And the ass was standing beside it, and the lion was standing beside the dead body. (1 Kings 13:24)

- **Also from presumptuous acts hold your servant back, do not let them dominate me. In that case I shall be complete, and I shall have remained innocent from much transgression. (Psalms 19:13)**
