- I, therefore, the prisoner in the Lord, entreat **you** to **walk worthily** of the calling with which **you** were called. (**Ephesians 4:1**)
- For all the peoples, for their part, will **walk** each one in the name of its god, but we, for our part, shall **walk** in the name of **Yehowah** our **God** to time indefinite, even forever. (**Micah 4:5**)
- For we are a product of his **work** and were created in union with Christ Jesus for **good works**, which **God** prepared in advance for us to **walk** in them. (**Ephesians 2:10**)
- That the **God** of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give **you** a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the **accurate knowledge** of him. (**Ephesians 1:17**)
- However, there also came to be false prophets among the people, as there will also be false teachers among **you**. These very ones will quietly bring in destructive sects and will disown even the owner that bought them, bringing speedy destruction upon themselves. (**2 Peter 2:1**)
- For that righteous man by what he saw and heard while dwelling among them from day to day was tormenting his righteous soul by reason of their lawless deeds. (**2 Peter 2:8**)
- And Enoch kept walking with the true **God**. Then he was no more, for **God** took him. (**Genesis 5:24**)
- And now make confession to **Yehowah** the **God** of **YOUR** forefathers and do his pleasure and separate yourselves from the peoples of the land and from the foreign wives. (**Ezra 10:11**)
- And on the second day the heads of the fathers of all the people, the priests and the Levites, gathered themselves together to Ezra the copyist, even to gain insight into the words of the Law. (**Nehemiah 8:13**)

- When **Yehowah** takes pleasure in the ways of a man he causes even his enemies themselves to be at peace with him. (**Proverbs 16:7**)
- Finally, the ones that were sown on the fine soil are those who listen to the word and favorably receive it and bear **fruit** thirtyfold and sixty and a hundred. (**Mark 4:20**)
- So, my brothers, **YOU** also were made dead to the Law through the body of the Christ, that **YOU** might become another's, the one's who was raised up from the dead, that we should bear **fruit to God**. (**Romans 7:4**)
- On the other hand, the fruitage of the spirit is love, joy, peace, long-suffering, kindness, goodness, faith. (**Galatians 5:22**)
- Only behave in a manner worthy of the **Good News** about the Christ, in order that, whether I come and see **YOU** or be absent, I may hear about the things which concern **YOU**, that **YOU** are standing firm in one spirit, with one soul striving side by side for the faith of the **Good News**. (**Philippians 1:27**)
- To the **end** that **YOU** should **go** on walking **worthily** of **God** who is calling **YOU** to his kingdom and glory. (**1 Thessalonians 2:12**)
- Finally, brothers, we request **YOU** and exhort **YOU** by the Lord Jesus, just as **YOU** received the instruction from us on how **YOU** ought to **walk** and please **God**, just as **YOU** are in fact walking, that **YOU** would keep on doing it more **fully**. (**1 Thessalonians 4:1**)
- Continue reminding them to be in subjection and be obedient to governments and authorities as rulers, to be ready for every **good work**. (**Titus 3:1**)
- But let our people also learn to maintain fine **works** so as to meet their pressing needs, that they may not be unfruitful. (**Titus 3:14**)
- I know your deeds, and your love and faith and ministry and endurance, and that your deeds of late are more than those formerly. (**Revelation 2:19**)
