[16] - References:

- Do not cease giving thanks for **YOU**. I continue mentioning **YOU** in my prayers. (**Ephesians 1:16**)
- Therefore openly confess **YOUR** sins to one another and pray for one another, that **YOU** may get healed. A righteous man's supplication, when it is at work, has much force. (**James 5:16**)
- And this is what I continue **praying**, that **YOUR** love may abound yet more and more with **accurate knowledge** and full discernment. (**Philippians 1:9**)
- But we speak God's **wisdom** in a sacred secret, the hidden **wisdom**, which God foreordained before the systems of things for our glory. (**1 Corinthians 2:7**)
- Carefully concealed in him are all the treasures of **wisdom** and of **knowledge**. (**Colossians 2:3**)
- Give constant thought to what I am saying, the Lord **will** really give you discernment in all things. (**2 Timothy 2:7**)
- But we know that the Son of God has come, and he has given us intellectual capacity that we may gain the **knowledge** of the true one. And we are in union with the true one, by means of his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and life everlasting. (**1 John 5:20**)
- As for me also, it is unthinkable, on my part, to sin against Yehowah by ceasing to pray in **YOUR** behalf, and I must instruct **YOU** in the good and right way. (**1 Samuel 12:23**)
- And on the second **day** the heads of the fathers of all the people, the priests and the Levites, gathered themselves together to Ezra the copyist, even to gain insight into the words of the Law. (**Nehemiah 8:13**)

- For **YOUR** obedience has come to the notice of all. I therefore rejoice over **YOU**. But I want **YOU** to be wise as to what is good, but innocent as to what is evil. (**Romans 16:19**)
- That in everything **you have** been enriched in him, in full ability to speak and in full **knowledge**. (**1 Corinthians 1:5**)
- And so, brothers, I was not able to speak to **you** as to **spiritual** men, but as to fleshly men, as to babes in Christ. (**1 Corinthians 3:1**)
- This he caused to abound toward us in all **wisdom** and good sense. (**Ephesians 1:8**)
- That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give **you** a spirit of **wisdom** and of revelation in the **accurate knowledge** of him. (**Ephesians 1:17**)
- Carry on prayer for us, for we trust we **have** an honest conscience, as we wish to conduct ourselves honestly in all things. (**Hebrews 13:18**)
- May undeserved kindness and peace be increased to **you** by an **accurate knowledge** of God and of Jesus our Lord. (**2 Peter 1:2**)
