- The insight of a man certainly slows down his anger, and it is beauty on his part to pass over transgression. (**Proverbs 19:11**)
- But become kind to one another, tenderly compassionate, **freely forgiving** one another just as God also by Christ **freely forgave you**. (**Ephesians 4:32**)
- Above all things, have intense love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins. (**1 Peter 4:8**)
- Moreover, if your brother commits a sin, go lay bare his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have gained your brother. (**Matthew 18:15**)
- And they will no more teach each one his companion and each one his brother, saying; **KNOW** Yehowah! For they will all of them know me, from the least one of them even to the greatest one of them, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. For I shall forgive their error, and their sin I shall remember no more. (**Jeremiah 31:34**)
- For if **YOU** forgive men their trespasses, **YOUR** heavenly Father will also forgive **YOU**. (**Matthew 6:14**)
- And when **YOU** stand praying, forgive whatever **YOU** have **against anyone**, in order that **YOUR** Father who is in the heavens may also forgive **YOU YOUR** trespasses. (**Mark 11:25**)
- He **has** flashed up in the darkness as a light to the upright ones. He is gracious and merciful and righteous. (**Psalms 112:4**)
- Jesus said to him; I say to you, not, up to seven times, but, up to seventy-seven times. (**Matthew 18:22**)
- And forgive us our sins, for we ourselves also forgive everyone that is in debt to us, and do not bring us into temptation. (**Luke 11:4**)

- **Even** if he sins seven times a day **against** you and he comes back to you seven times, saying, I repent, you must forgive him. (**Luke 17:4**)
- Does not behave indecently, does not look for its own interests, does not become provoked. It does not keep account of the injury. (**1 Corinthians 13:5**)
- By purity, by knowledge, by long-suffering, by kindness, by Holy Spirit, by love free from hypocrisy. (**2 Corinthians 6:6**)
- Be wrathful, and yet do not sin, let the sun not set with **YOU** in a provoked state. (**Ephesians 4:26**)
- On the other hand, we exhort **YOU**, brothers, admonish the disorderly, speak consolingly to the depressed souls, support the weak, be long-suffering toward all. (**1 Thessalonians 5:14**)
