

## YEHOWAH - AGAINST THE WICKED

~ **Men ... Unrighteous ... Yehowah Against Wicked** - Look I am raising up against you a nation and they must oppress you throughout your land. (Amos 6:14) <sup>[13]</sup> - References

Amos 6:14· **Look! I am raising up against you, O house of Israel, is the utterance of Yehowah the God of the armies, a nation, and they must oppress you people from the entering in of Hamath down to the torrent valley of the Arabah.**

<sup>[13]</sup> - References

- **Yehowah** will raise up **against** you a **nation** far away, from the end of the earth, just as an eagle pounces, a **nation** whose tongue you will not understand. (Deuteronomy 28:49)
- In the days of Pekah the king of Israel, Tiglath-pileser the king of Assyria came in and proceeded to take Ijon and Abel-beth-maacah and Janoah and Kedesh and Hazor and Gilead and Galilee, all the land of Naphtali, and to carry them into exile in Assyria. (2 Kings 15:29)
- In the ninth year of Hoshea, the king of Assyria captured Samaria and then led Israel into exile in Assyria and kept them dwelling in Halah and in Habor at the river Gozan and in the cities of the Medes. (2 Kings 17:6)
- In that day, by means of a hired razor in the region of the River, even by means of the king of Assyria, **Yehowah** will shave the head and the hair of the feet, and it will sweep away even the beard itself. (Isaiah 7:20)
- For before the boy will know how to call out; My father! And; My mother! One will carry away the resources of Damascus and the spoil of Samaria before the king of Assyria. (Isaiah 8:4)
- Aha, the Assyrian, the rod for my anger, and the stick that is in their hand for my denunciation! (Isaiah 10:5)
- Even it someone will bring to Assyria itself as a gift to a great king. Shame is what Ephraim himself will get, and Israel will be ashamed of its counsel. (Hosea 10:6)

- From Mount Hor **you** will mark out the boundary to the **entering** in of **Hamath**, and the termination of the boundary **must** prove to be at Zedad. (**Numbers 34:8**)
- And Solomon proceeded to carry on at that time the festival, and all Israel with him, a great congregation from the **entering** in of **Hamath down** to the **torrent valley** of Egypt, before **Yehowah** our **God** seven days and another seven days, fourteen days. (**1 Kings 8:65**)
- He it was that restored the boundary of Israel from the **entering** in of **Hamath** clear to the sea of the **Arabah**, according to the word of **Yehowah** the **God** of Israel who spoke by means of his servant Jonah the son of Amittai, the prophet that was from Gath-hepher. (**2 Kings 14:25**)
- Let your voice out in shrill cries, O daughter of Gallim. Pay attention, O Laishah. O you afflicted one, Anathoth! (**Isaiah 10:30**)
- Here I **am** sending and I will take all the families of the north, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah**, even sending to Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, my servant, and I will bring them **against** this land and **against** its inhabitants and **against** all these **nations** round about, and I will devote them to destruction and make them an object of astonishment and something to whistle at and places devastated to time indefinite. (**Jeremiah 25:9**)
- And **Hamath** itself will also border upon her, Tyre and Sidon, for she is very wise. (**Zechariah 9:2**)
