**Deuteronomy 1:31**.. **And in the wilderness, where you saw how Yehowah your God carried you just as a man carries his son, in all the way that YOU walked until YOUR coming to this place.**

[12] - References

- He proceeded to split rocks in the wilderness, that he might cause them to drink an abundance **just** like watery deeps. (**Psalms 78:15**)
- **You** yourselves have seen what I did to the Egyptians, that I might carry **YOU** on wings of eagles and bring **YOU** to myself. (**Exodus 19:4**)
- Just as an eagle stirs up its nest, hovers over its fledglings, spreads out its wings, takes them, **carries** them on its pinions. (**Deuteronomy 32:11**)
- You have led your people **just** like a flock, by the hand of Moses and Aaron. (**Psalms 77:20**)
- But all the men who have been seeing my glory and my signs that I have performed in Egypt and in the wilderness and yet kept testing me these ten times, and have not listened to my voice. (**Numbers 14:22**)
- **Yehowah** alone kept leading him, and there was no foreign god along with him. (**Deuteronomy 32:12**)
- Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth, for **Yehowah** himself has spoken; Sons I have brought up and raised, but they themselves have revolted against me. (**Isaiah 1:2**)
- Listen to me, O house of Jacob, and all **YOU** remaining ones of the house of Israel, **YOU** the ones conveyed by me from the belly, the ones **carried** from the womb. (**Isaiah 46:3**)

- During all their distress it was distressing to him. And his own personal messenger saved them. In his love and in his compassion he himself repurchased them, and he proceeded to lift them up and carry them all the days of long ago. (**Isaiah 63:9**)
- This is what **Yehowah** has said; The people made up of survivors from the sword found favor in the wilderness, when Israel was walking to get his repose. (**Jeremiah 31:2**)
- Not one like the covenant that I concluded with their forefathers in the day of my taking hold of their hand to bring them forth out of the land of Egypt, which covenant of mine they themselves broke, although I myself had husbandly ownership of them, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 31:32**)
- But as for me, I taught Ephraim to walk, taking them upon my arms, and they did not recognize that I had healed them. (**Hosea 11:3**)
