Men … Unrighteous … Yehowah Disciplines Unrighteous -Yehowah is righteous for it is against his mouth that I have rebelled, listen now you peoples and see my pain, all my young ones have gone into captivity (Lamentations 1:18) [11] - References

I have rebelled. Listen, now, all you peoples, and see my pain. My own virgins and my own young men have gone into captivity.

[11] - References

- The Rock, perfect is his activity, for all his ways are justice. A God of faithfulness, with whom there is no injustice. Righteous and upright is he. (Deuteronomy 32:4)
- And you are righteous as regards all that has come upon us, for faithfully is how you have acted, but we are the ones that have done wickedly. (Nehemiah 9:33)
- To you, O Yehowah, there belongs the righteousness, but to us the shame of face as at this day, to the men of Judah and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem and to all those of Israel, those nearby and those far away in all the lands to which you dispersed them because of their unfaithfulness with which they acted against you. (Daniel 9:7)
- If you will fear Yehowah and actually serve him and obey his voice, and you will not rebel against the order of Yehowah, both you and the king who must reign over you will certainly prove to be followers of Yehowah your God. (1 Samuel 12:14)
- But if you will not obey the voice of Yehowah and you will actually rebel against the order of Yehowah, the hand of Yehowah will certainly prove to be against you and your fathers. (1 Samuel 12:15)
- For they had behaved rebelliously against the sayings of God, and the counsel of the Most High they had disrespected. (Psalms 107:11)
- Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth, for Yehowah himself has spoken; Sons I have brought up and raised, but they themselves have revolted against me. (Isaiah 1:2)

- Your sons and your daughters given to another people and your eyes looking on and yearning for them always, but your hands will be without power. (Deuteronomy 28:32)
- Yehowah is righteous. He has cut in pieces the ropes of the wicked ones. (Psalms 129:4)
