Proverbs 15:29· Yehowah is far away from the wicked ones, but the prayer of the righteous ones he hears.

- The face of Yehowah is against those doing what is bad, to cut off the mention of them from the very earth. **(Psalms 34:16)**
- For Yehowah is high, and yet the humble one he sees, but the lofty one he knows only from a distance. **(Psalms 138:6)**
- For the eyes of Yehowah are upon the **righteous ones**, and his ears are toward their supplication, but the face of Yehowah is against those doing bad things. **(1 Peter 3:12)**
- The eyes of Yehowah are toward the **righteous ones**, and his ears are toward their cry for help. **(Psalms 34:15)**
- The desire of those fearing him he will perform, and their cry for help he will hear, and he will save them. **(Psalms 145:19)**
- In that case you would call, and Yehowah himself would answer, you would cry for help, and he would say, Here I am! If you will remove from your midst the yoke bar, the poking out of the finger and the speaking of what is hurtful. **(Isaiah 58:9)**
- We know that God does not listen to sinners, but if anyone is God-fearing and does his will, he listens to this one. **(John 9:31)**
- At Aaron, too, Yehowah got very incensed to the point of annihilating him, but I made supplication also in behalf of Aaron at that particular time. **(Deuteronomy 9:20)**
- And I began to make supplication to Yehowah and to say, O Sovereign Lord Yehowah, do not bring to ruin your people, even your private property, whom you redeemed with your greatness, whom you brought out of Egypt with a strong hand. **(Deuteronomy 9:26)**

• Then they got up early in the morning and prostrated themselves before Yehowah, after which they returned and came into their house at Ramah. Elkanah now had intercourse with Hannah his wife, and Yehowah began remembering her. (**1 Samuel 1:19**)

• To this Elisha said; As Yehowah of armies before whom I do stand is living, if it were not that it is the face of Jehoshaphat the king of Judah for which I am having consideration, I would not look at you or see you. (**2 Kings 3:14**)

• Ah, Yehowah, please, let your ear become attentive to the **prayer** of your servant and to the **prayer** of your servants who take delight in fearing your name, and, please, do grant success to your servant today and make him an object of pity before this man. Now I myself happened to be cupbearer to the king. (**Nehemiah 1:11**)

• If I called him, would he answer me? I do not believe that he would give ear to my voice. (**Job 9:16**)

• Only the untruth God does not hear, and the Almighty himself does not behold it. (**Job 35:13**)

• As for me, I said when I became panicky; I shall certainly be exterminated from in front of your eyes. Surely you have heard the voice of my entreaties when I cried to you for help. (**Psalms 31:22**)

• O God, hear my **prayer**, do give ear to the sayings of my mouth. (**Psalms 54:2**)

• If I have regarded anything hurtful in my heart, Yehowah will not hear me. (**Psalms 66:18**)

• With my voice I will even cry out to God himself, with my voice to God, and he will certainly give ear to me. (**Psalms 77:1**)

• Incline, O Yehowah, your ear. Answer me, for I am afflicted and poor. (**Psalms 86:1**)

• When he is judged, let him go forth as someone **wicked**, and let his very **prayer** become a sin. (**Psalms 109:7**)

• Salvation is **far away** from the **wicked ones**, for they have not searched for your own regulations. (**Psalms 119:155**)

• He that is turning his ear **away** from hearing the Law, even his **prayer** is something detestable. (**Proverbs 28:9**)

• Go, and you must say to Hezekiah; This is what Yehowah the God of David your forefather has said; I have heard your **prayer**. I

have seen your tears. Here I am adding onto your days fifteen years. (Isaiah 38:5)

- I myself shall tell forth your righteousness and your works, that they will not benefit you. (Isaiah 57:12)

- For what reason did we fast and you did not see, and did we afflict our soul and you would take no note? Indeed YOU people were finding delight in the very day of YOUR fasting, when there were all YOUR toilers that YOU kept driving to work. (Isaiah 58:3)

- No, but the very errors of YOU people have become the things causing division between YOU and YOUR God, and YOUR own sins have caused the concealing of his face from YOU to keep from hearing. (Isaiah 59:2)

- Also, when I call for aid and cry for help, he actually hampers my prayer. (Lamentations 3:8)

- You have blocked approach to yourself with a cloud mass, that prayer may not pass through. (Lamentations 3:44)

- And I proceeded to set my face to Yehowah the true God, in order to seek him with prayer and with entreaties, with fasting and sackcloth and ashes. (Daniel 9:3)

- And he went on to say to me; Do not be afraid, O Daniel, for from the first day that you gave your heart to understanding and humbling yourself before your God your words have been heard, and I myself have come because of your words. (Daniel 10:12)

- The man gazed at him and, becoming frightened, said; What is it, Lord? He said to him; Your prayers and gifts of mercy have ascended as a remembrance before God. (Acts of Apostles 10:4)

- And this is the confidence that we have toward him, that, no matter what it is that we ask according to his will, he hears us. (1 John 5:14)
