- And I shall make a **great** nation out of you and I shall bless you and I will make your name **great**, and prove yourself a blessing. (**Genesis 12:2**)
- The blessing of **Yehowah**, that is what makes rich, and he adds no pain with it. (**Proverbs 10:22**)
- And you must remember all the way that **Yehowah** your **God** made you walk these **forty years** in the **wilderness**, in order to humble you, to put you to the test so as to know what was in your heart, as to whether you would keep his commandments or not. (**Deuteronomy 8:2**)
- For **forty years** I kept feeling a loathing toward that generation, and I proceeded to say; They are a people wayward at heart, and they themselves **have** not come to know my ways. (**Psalms 95:10**)
- And for a period of about **forty years** he put up with their manner of action in the **wilderness**. (**Acts of Apostles 13:18**)
- And for **forty years** you provided them with food in the **wilderness**. They **lacked** nothing. Their very garments did not wear out, and their feet themselves did not become swollen. (**Nehemiah 9:21**)
- **Yehowah** is my Shepherd. I shall lack nothing. (**Psalms 23:1**)
- Fear **Yehowah**, **you** holy ones of his, for there is no lack to those fearing him. (**Psalms 34:9**)

- The maned young lions themselves **have** had little on **hand** and gone hungry, but as for those seeking **Yehowah**, they will not lack anything good. (**Psalms 34:10**)
- A young man I used to be, I **have** also grown old, and yet I **have** not seen anyone righteous left entirely, nor his offspring looking for bread. (**Psalms 37:25**)
- In turn, my **God** will fully supply all **YOUR** need to the extent of his riches in glory by means of Christ Jesus. (**Philippians 4:19**)
- **You have** gone around this mountain long enough. Change **YOUR** direction to the north. (**Deuteronomy 2:3**)
- Go, and you must call out in the ears of Jerusalem, saying; This is what **Yehowah has** said; I **well** remember, on your part, the loving-kindness of your youth, the love during your being engaged to marry, your **walking** after me in the **wilderness**, in a land not sown with seed. (**Jeremiah 2:2**)
