Deuteronomy 31:6· **BE** courageous and strong. Do not be afraid or suffer a shock before them, because Yehowah your God is the one marching with you. He will neither desert you nor leave you entirely.

- Be **courageous** and **strong**, for you are the one who **will** cause this people to inherit the land that I swore to their forefathers to give to them. (**Joshua 1:6**)
- Hope in **Yehowah**, be **courageous** and let your heart be **strong**. Yes, hope in **Yehowah**. (**Psalms 27:14**)
- **Yehowah** is on my side, I shall not fear. What can earthling man do to me? (**Psalms 118:6**)
- Only against **Yehowah** do not rebel, and **you**, do not **you** fear the people of the land, for they are bread to us. Their shelter has turned away from over them, and **Yehowah** is with us. Do not fear them. (**Numbers 14:9**)
- So I said to **you**, **you** must not **suffer** a **shock** or be **afraid** because of them. (**Deuteronomy 1:29**)
- You must not be **afraid** of them. You should by all means remember what **Yehowah** your **God** did to Pharaoh and all Egypt. (**Deuteronomy 7:18**)
- Whatever day I get **afraid**, I, for my part, shall trust even in you. (**Psalms 56:3**)
- For **Yehowah** your **God** is a merciful **God**. He **will** not **desert** you or bring you to ruin or forget the covenant of your forefathers that he swore to them. (**Deuteronomy 4:31**)
- Nobody **will** take a firm stand **before** you all the days of your life. Just as I proved to be with Moses I shall prove to be with you. I shall neither **desert** you nor **leave** you entirely. (**Joshua 1:5**)

- Let **YOUR** manner of life be free of the love of money, while **YOU** are content with the present things. For he has said; **I will** by no means **leave** you nor by any means forsake you. (**Hebrews 13:5**)
- And what the land is, whether it is fat or lean, whether there are trees in it or not. And **YOU** must show yourselves **courageous** and take some of the fruitage of the land. Now the days were the days of the first ripe fruits of the grapes. (**Numbers 13:20**)
- See, **Yehowah** your **God** has abandoned the land to you. Go up, take possession, just as **Yehowah** the **God** of your forefathers has spoken to you. Do not be **afraid**, nor be terrified. (**Deuteronomy 1:21**)
- In case you go out to the battle against your enemies and you actually see horses and war chariots, a people more numerous than you, you must not be **afraid** of them, for **Yehowah** your **God** is with you, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt. (**Deuteronomy 20:1**)
- So **Yehowah** proved to be with Joshua, and his fame came to be in all the earth. (**Joshua 6:27**)
- And Joshua went on to say to them; Do not be **afraid** or be terrified. Be **courageous** and **strong**, for it is like this that **Yehowah will** do to all **YOUR** enemies against whom **YOU** are warring. (**Joshua 10:25**)
- But the mountainous region should become yours. Because it is a forest, you must cut it down, and it must become the termination point for you. For you should drive away the Canaanites, although they have war chariots with iron scythes and they are strong. (**Joshua 17:18**)
- Be **strong**, that we may show ourselves **courageous** in behalf of our people and in behalf of the cities of our **God**, and as for **Yehowah**, he **will** do what is good in his own eyes. (**2 Samuel 10:12**)
- I am going in the way of all the earth, and you must be **strong** and prove yourself to be a man. (**1 Kings 2:2**)
- May **Yehowah** our **God** prove to be with us just as he proved to be with our forefathers. May he neither **leave** us nor forsake us. (**1 Kings 8:57**)
- Be **strong**, that we may show ourselves **courageous** in behalf of our people and in behalf of the cities of our **God**, and as for **Yehowah**, what is good in his own eyes he **will** do. (**1 Chronicles 19:13**)
- In that case you **will** prove successful if you take care to carry out the regulations and the judicial decisions that **Yehowah**

commanded Moses respecting Israel. Be **courageous** and **strong**. Do not be **afraid** nor be terrified. (**1 Chronicles 22:13**)

· And David went on to say to Solomon his son; Be **courageous** and **strong** and act. Do not be **afraid** nor be terrified, for **Yehowah God**, my **God**, is with you. He **will** not **desert** you or **leave** you until all the work of the service of Yehowah's house is finished. (**1 Chronicles 28:20**)

· Be **courageous** and **strong**. Do not be **afraid** nor be terrified because of the king of Assyria and on account of all the crowd that is with him, for with us there are more than there are with him. (**2 Chronicles 32:7**)

· Do not be **afraid** because of their faces, for I am with you to deliver you, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 1:8**)
