- Many are the calamities of the righteous one, but **out** of them all Yehowah **delivers** him. (**Psalms 34:19**)
- No temptation has taken **you** except what is common to men. But God is faithful, and he will not let **you** be tempted beyond what **you** can bear, but along with the temptation he will also make the way **out** in order for **you** to be able to endure it. (**1 Corinthians 10:13**)
- The Lord will **deliver** me from every wicked work and will save me for his heavenly kingdom. To him be the glory forever and ever. Amen. (**2 Timothy 4:18**)
- Because you kept the word about my endurance, I will also keep you from the hour of test, which is to come upon the whole inhabited earth, to put a test upon those dwelling on the earth. (**Revelation 3:10**)
- But according to your hardness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself on the **day** of wrath and of the revealing of God's righteous **judgment**. (**Romans 2:5**)
- But by the same word the heavens and the earth that are now are stored up for fire and are being reserved to the **day** of **judgment** and of destruction of the ungodly men. (**2 Peter 3:7**)
- After that Yehowah said to Noah; Go, you and all your household, into the ark, because you are the one I have seen to be righteous before me among this generation. (**Genesis 7:1**)
- Thus he wiped **out** every existing thing that was on the surface of the ground, from man to beast, to moving animal and to flying creature

of the heavens, and they were wiped off the earth, and only Noah and those who were with him in the ark kept on surviving. (**Genesis 7:23**)

• Please, here I have two daughters who have never had intercourse with a man. Please, let me bring them **out** to **you**. Then do to them as is good in **YOUR** eyes. Only to these men do not do a thing, because that is why they have come under the shadow of my roof. (**Genesis 19:8**)

• When he kept lingering, then in the compassion of Yehowah upon him, the men seized hold of his hand and of the hand of his wife and of the hands of his two daughters and they proceeded to bring him **out** and to station him outside the city. (**Genesis 19:16**)

• Deliver me, I pray you, from my brother's hand, from Esau's hand, because I am afraid of him that he may come and certainly assault me, mother together with children. (**Genesis 32:11**)

• Then Joshua said to the **people**; **You** are not able to serve Yehowah, for he is a holy God, he is a God exacting exclusive **devotion**. He will not pardon **YOUR** revolting and **YOUR** sins. (**Joshua 24:19**)

• And David went running away from Naioth in Ramah. However, he came and said in front of Jonathan; What have I done? What is my error, and what sin have I committed before your father, for he is seeking for my soul? (**1 Samuel 20:1**)

• And, look! Just as your soul was great this **day** in my eyes, so may my soul be great in the eyes of Yehowah, that he may **deliver me out** of all distress. (**1 Samuel 26:24**)

• And now rise up early in the morning with the servants of your lord that came with you, and **you** men must rise up early in the morning when it has become light for **you**. Then go. (**1 Samuel 29:10**)

• And now do not leave him unpunished, for you are a wise man and you well know what you ought to do to him, and you must bring his gray hairs down to Sheol with blood. (**1 Kings 2:9**)

• And it must occur that from the torrent valley you should drink, and the ravens I shall certainly command to supply you food there. (**1 Kings 17:4**)

• And I shall indeed forsake the remnant of my inheritance and give them into the hand of their enemies, and they will simply become plunder and pillage to all their enemies. (**2 Kings 21:14**)

- And they proceeded to hang Haman on the stake that he had prepared for Mordecai, and the king's rage itself subsided. (**Esther 7:10**)
- On that **day** King Ahasuerus gave to Esther the queen the house of Haman, the one showing hostility to the Jews, and Mordecai himself came in before the king, because Esther had told what he was to her. (**Esther 8:1**)
- That at the **day** of disaster an evil one is spared, at the **day** of fury he is delivered? (**Job 21:30**)
- He will rescue an innocent man, and you will certainly be rescued for the cleanness of your hands. (**Job 22:30**)
- He will not preserve anyone wicked alive, but the **judgment** of the afflicted ones he will give. (**Job 36:6**)
- O Yehowah my God, in you I have taken refuge. Save me from all those persecuting me and **deliver** me. (**Psalms 7:1**)
- For evildoers themselves will be **cut** off, but those hoping in Yehowah are the ones that will possess the earth. (**Psalms 37:9**)
- As for Yehowah, he will not leave him to the hand of that one, and he will not pronounce him wicked when he is being judged. (**Psalms 37:33**)
- But the transgressors themselves will certainly be annihilated together, the future of wicked **people** will indeed be **cut** off. (**Psalms 37:38**)
- Yehowah himself will guard him and preserve him alive. He will be pronounced happy in the earth, and you cannot possibly give him over to the soul of his enemies. (**Psalms 41:2**)
- To give him quietness from **days** of calamity, until for the wicked one a pit is excavated. (**Psalms 94:13**)
- Precious in the eyes of Yehowah is the death of his loyal ones. (**Psalms 116:15**)
- I have executed **judgment** and righteousness. O do not abandon me to those defrauding me! (**Psalms 119:121**)
- As for the one listening to me, he will reside in security and be undisturbed from dread of calamity. (**Proverbs 1:33**)

- By the transgression of the lips the bad person is ensnared, but the righteous one gets **out** of distress. (**Proverbs 12:13**)
- Everything Yehowah has made for his purpose, yes, even the wicked one for the evil **day**. (**Proverbs 16:4**)
- Although a sinner may be doing bad a hundred times and continuing a long time as he pleases, yet I am also aware that it will turn **out** well with those fearing the true God, because they were in fear of him. (**Ecclesiastes 8:12**)
- Further, the king commanded Jerahmeel the son of the king and Seraiah the son of Azriel and Shelemiah the son of Abdeel to get Baruch the secretary and Jeremiah the prophet. But Yehowah kept them concealed. (**Jeremiah 36:26**)
- Therefore untruth **YOU** women will not keep on visioning, and divination **YOU** will divine no longer, and I will **deliver** my **people out** of **YOUR** hand, and **YOU** will have to know that I am Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 13:23**)
- And had these three men proved to be in the midst of it, Noah, Daniel and Job, they themselves because of their righteousness would **deliver** their soul, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 14:14**)
- Even were these three men in the midst of it, as I am alive, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, they would **deliver** neither sons nor daughters, but they, only they themselves, would be delivered. (**Ezekiel 14:18**)
- Even for them to ask for mercies on the part of the God of heaven concerning this secret, in order, that they might not destroy Daniel and his companions with the remainder of the wise men of Babylon. (**Daniel 2:18**)
- Yehowah is a God exacting exclusive **devotion** and taking vengeance, Yehowah is taking vengeance and is disposed to rage. Yehowah is taking vengeance against his adversaries, and he is resentful toward his enemies. (**Nahum 1:2**)
- And these will depart into everlasting cutting-off, but the righteous ones into everlasting life. (**Matthew 25:46**)
- And come **out**, those who did good things to a resurrection of life, those who practiced vile things to a resurrection of **judgment**. (**John 5:29**)

- And Peter, coming to himself, said; Now I actually know that Yehowah sent his angel forth and delivered me **out** of Herod's hand and from all that the **people** of the Jews were expecting. (**Acts of Apostles 12:11**)
- From such a great thing as death he did rescue us and will rescue us, and our hope is in him that he will also rescue us further. (**2 Corinthians 1:10**)
- But the Lord is faithful, and he will make **YOU** firm and keep **YOU** from the wicked one. (**2 Thessalonians 3:3**)
- To **YOUR** knowledge self-control, to **YOUR** self-control endurance, to **YOUR** endurance **godly devotion**. (**2 Peter 1:6**)
- Saying in a loud voice; **FEAR** God and give him glory, because the hour of the **judgment** by him has arrived, and so worship the One who made the heaven and the earth and sea and fountains of waters. (**Revelation 14:7**)
