- And therefore Yehowah will keep in expectation of showing **YOU** favor, and therefore he will rise up to show **YOU** mercy. For Yehowah is a God of judgment. Happy are all those keeping in expectation of him. (**Isaiah 30:18**)
- How shall we escape if we have neglected a salvation of such greatness in that it began to be spoken through our Lord and was verified for us by those who heard him. (**Hebrews 2:3**)
- When the very **people** in Zion will dwell in Jerusalem, you will by no means weep. He will without fail show you favor at the sound of your outcry, as soon as he hears it he will actually answer you. (**Isaiah 30:19**)
- Or do you despise the riches of his kindness and forbearance and long-suffering, because you do not know that the kindly quality of God is trying to lead you to **repentance**? (**Romans 2:4**)
- After that Yehowah said; My spirit shall not act toward man indefinitely in that he is also flesh. Accordingly his days shall amount to a hundred and twenty years. (**Genesis 6:3**)
- Hurry! Escape there, because I am not able to do a thing until your arriving there! That is why he called the name of the city Zoar. (**Genesis 19:22**)
- And Yehowah went passing by before his face and declaring; Yehowah, Yehowah, a God merciful and gracious, **slow** to anger and abundant in loving-kindness and truth. (**Exodus 34:6**)

- While he was yet speaking with them, here was the messenger coming down to him, and the king proceeded to say; Here this is the calamity from Yehowah. Why should I wait any longer for Yehowah? **(2 Kings 6:33)**
- These things you have done, and I kept silent. You imagined that I would positively become like you. I am going to reprove you, and I will set things in order before your eyes. **(Psalms 50:21)**
- Because sentence against a bad work has not been executed speedily, that is why the heart of the sons of men has become fully set in them to do bad. **(Ecclesiastes 8:11)**
- But if **you people** refuse and are actually rebellious, with a sword **you** will be eaten up, for the very mouth of Yehowah has spoken it. **(Isaiah 1:20)**
- Look! I and the children whom Yehowah has given me are as signs and as miracles in Israel from Yehowah of armies, who is residing in Mount Zion. **(Isaiah 8:18)**
- I have kept quiet for a long time. I continued silent. I kept exercising self-control. Like a woman giving birth I am going to groan, pant, and gasp at the same time. **(Isaiah 42:14)**
- I have paid attention, and I kept listening. It was not right the way they kept speaking. There was not a man repenting over his badness, saying; What have I done? Each one is going back into the popular course, like a horse that is dashing into the battle. **(Jeremiah 8:6)**
- They saying; Turn back, please, every one from his bad way and from the badness of **YOUR** dealings, and continue dwelling upon the ground that Yehowah gave to **YOU** and to **YOUR** forefathers from long ago and to a long time to come. **(Jeremiah 25:5)**
- For not out of his own heart has he afflicted or does he grieve the sons of men. **(Lamentations 3:33)**
- Do I take any delight at all in the death of someone wicked, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, and not in that he should turn back from his ways and actually keep living? **(Ezekiel 18:23)**
- For I do not take any delight in the death of someone dying, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. So cause a turning back and keep living, O **you people**. **(Ezekiel 18:32)**

· Say to them; As I am alive, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, I take delight, not in the death of the wicked one, but in that someone wicked turns back from his way and actually keeps living. Turn back, turn back from **YOUR** bad ways, for why is it that **YOU** should die, O house of Israel? (**Ezekiel 33:11**)

· Why is it that you make me see what is hurtful, and you keep looking upon mere trouble? And why are despoiling and violence in front of me, and why does quarreling occur, and why is strife carried? (**Habakkuk 1:3**)

· Before the statute gives birth to anything, before the day has passed by just like chaff, before there comes upon **you people** the burning anger of Yehowah, before there comes upon **you** the day of Yehowah's anger. (**Zephaniah 2:2**)

· I said; Surely you will fear me, you will accept discipline, so that her dwelling might not be cut off, all that I must call to account against her. Truly they acted promptly in making all their dealings ruinous. (**Zephaniah 3:7**)

· Likewise it is not a desirable thing with my Father who is in heaven for one of these little ones to perish. (**Matthew 18:14**)

· And if then it produces fruit in the future, well and good, but if not, you shall cut it down. (**Luke 13:9**)

· Certainly, then, shall not God cause justice to be done for his chosen ones who cry out to him day and night, even though he is long-suffering toward them? (**Luke 18:7**)

· For yet a very little while, and he who is coming will arrive and will not delay. (**Hebrews 10:37**)

· Also, with covetousness they will exploit **you** with counterfeit words. But as for them, the judgment from of old is not moving slowly, and the destruction of them is not slumbering. (**2 Peter 2:3**)
