Moses ··· Statement ··· Yehowah's Requirements - What is Yehowah asking back except to fear Yehowah, walk in all his ways and to love him exclusively (Deuteronomy 10:12) [33] - References

Deuteronomy 10:12. And now, O Israel, what is Yehowah your God asking of you but to fear Yehowah your God, so as to walk in all his ways and to love him and to serve Yehowah your God with all your heart and all your soul;

[33] - References

- He has told you, O earthling man, what is good. And what is Yehowah asking back from you but to exercise justice and to love kindness and to be modest in walking with your God? (Micah 6:8)
- If only they would develop this heart of theirs to fear me and to keep all my commandments always, in order, that it might go well with them and their sons to time indefinite! (Deuteronomy 5:29)
- Yehowah your God you should fear, and him you should serve, and by his name you should swear. (Deuteronomy 6:13)
- Fear Yehowah, you holy ones of his, for there is no lack to those fearing him. (Psalms 34:9)
- The fear of Yehowah means the hating of bad. Self-exaltation and pride and the bad way and the perverse mouth I have hated. (Proverbs 8:13)
- In all the way that Yehowah Your God has commanded You, You should walk, in order, that You may live and it may be well with You and You may indeed lengthen Your days in the land of which You will take possession. (Deuteronomy 5:33)
- Only be very careful to carry out the commandment and the Law that Moses the servant of Yehowah commanded you by loving Yehowah your God and by walking in all his ways and by keeping his commandments and by cleaving to him and by serving him with all your heart and with all your soul. (Joshua 22:5)

- In order that they may walk in my own statutes and keep my own judicial decisions and actually carry them out, and they may really become my people and I myself may become their God. (Ezekiel 11:20)
- If you will listen to the commandments of Yehowah your God, which I am commanding you today, so as to love Yehowah your God, to walk in his ways and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judicial decisions, then you will be bound to keep alive and to multiply, and Yehowah your God must bless you in the land to which you are going to take possession of it. (Deuteronomy 30:16)
- And you must love Yehowah your God with all your heart and all your soul and all your vital force. (Deuteronomy 6:5)
- And it must occur that if you will without fail obey my commandments that I am commanding you today so as to love Yehowah your God and to serve him with all your heart and all your soul. (Deuteronomy 11:13)
- In answer he said; You must love Yehowah your God with your whole heart and with your whole soul and with your whole strength and with your whole mind, and, your neighbor as yourself. (Luke 10:27)
- And you must serve Yehowah your God, and he will certainly bless your bread and your water, and I shall indeed turn malady away from your midst. (Exodus 23:25)
- Hence Yehowah commanded us to carry out all these regulations, to fear Yehowah our God for our good always, that we might keep alive as at this day. (Deuteronomy 6:24)
- And you must love Yehowah your God and keep your obligation to him and his statutes and his judicial decisions and his commandments always. (Deuteronomy 11:1)
- I also shall certainly give rain for YOUR land at its appointed time, autumn rain and spring rain, and you will indeed gather your grain and your sweet wine and your oil. (Deuteronomy 11:14)
- You must not listen to the words of that prophet or to the dreamer of that dream, because Yehowah your God is testing you to know whether you are loving Yehowah your God with all your heart and all your soul. (Deuteronomy 13:3)
- By loving Yehowah your God, by listening to his voice and by sticking to him, for he is your life and the length of your days, that you

may dwell upon the ground that Yehowah swore to your forefathers Abraham, Isaac and Jacob to give to them. (Deuteronomy 30:20)

- And now fear Yehowah and serve him in faultlessness and in truth, and remove the gods that YOUR forefathers served on the other side of the River and in Egypt, and serve Yehowah. (Joshua 24:14)
- If you will fear Yehowah and actually serve him and obey his voice, and you will not rebel against the order of Yehowah, both you and the king who must reign over you will certainly prove to be followers of Yehowah your God. (1 Samuel 12:14)
- Only fear Yehowah, and you must serve him in truth with all your heart, for see what great things he has done for you. (1 Samuel 12:24)
- In order that Yehowah may carry out his word that he spoke respecting me, saying; If your sons will take care of their way by walking before me in truth with all their heart and with all their soul, there will not be cut off a man of yours from sitting upon the throne of Israel. (1 Kings 2:4)
- And Solomon continued to love Yehowah by walking in the statutes of David his father. Only it was on the high places that he was regularly sacrificing and making offerings smoke. (1 Kings 3:3)
- And Jehu himself did not take care to walk in the Law of Yehowah the God of Israel with all his heart. He did not turn aside from the sins of Jeroboam with which he caused Israel to sin. (2 Kings 10:31)
- And the king kept standing by the pillar and now concluded the covenant before Yehowah, to walk after Yehowah and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his statutes with all the heart and with all the soul by carrying out the words of this covenant that were written in this book. Accordingly all the people took their stand in the covenant. (2 Kings 23:3)
- And you, Solomon my son, know the God of your father and serve him with a complete heart and with a delightful soul, for all hearts Yehowah is searching, and every inclination of the thoughts he is discerning. If you search for him, he will let himself be found by you, but if you leave him, he will cast you off forever. (1 Chronicles 28:9)
- And in every work that he started in the service of the house of the true God and in the Law and in the commandment to search for his God, it was with all his heart that he acted, and he proved successful. (2 Chronicles 31:21)

- And the king kept standing in his place and proceeded to conclude the covenant before Yehowah to go following Yehowah and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his regulations with all his heart and with all his soul, to perform the words of the covenant that were written in this book. (2 Chronicles 34:31)
- The fear of Yehowah is pure, standing forever. The judicial decisions of Yehowah are true, they have proved altogether righteous. (Psalms 19:9)
- O love Yehowah, all you loyal ones of his. The faithful ones Yehowah is safeguarding, but he is rewarding exceedingly anyone showing haughtiness. (Psalms 31:23)
- The conclusion of the matter, everything having been heard, is; Fear the true God and keep his commandments. For this is the whole obligation of man. (Ecclesiastes 12:13)
- These are the things that you people should do. Speak truthfully with one another. With truth and the judgment of peace do your judging in your gates. (Zechariah 8:16)
- He said to him; You must love Yehowah your God with your whole heart and with your whole soul and with your whole mind. (Matthew 22:37)
