Numbers 14:18· **Yehowah, slow to anger and abundant in loving-kindness, pardoning error and transgression, but by no means will he give exemption from punishment, bringing punishment for the error of the fathers upon sons, upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation.**

- And Yehowah went passing by before his face and declaring; Yehowah, Yehowah, a God merciful and gracious, **slow to anger** and **abundant in loving-kindness** and truth. **(Exodus 34:6)**
- If, now, God, although having the **will** to demonstrate his wrath and to make his power known, tolerated with much long-suffering vessels of wrath made fit for destruction. **(Romans 9:22)**
- Yehowah is merciful and gracious, **slow to anger** and **abundant in loving-kindness**. **(Psalms 103:8)**
- Hence he prayed to Yehowah and said; Ah, now, O Yehowah, was not this an affair of mine, while I happened to be on my own ground? That is why I went ahead and ran away to Tarshish, for I knew that you are a God gracious and merciful, **slow to anger** and **abundant in loving-kindness**, and feeling regret over the calamity. **(Jonah 4:2)**
- Who is a God like you, one **pardoning error** and passing over **transgression** of the remnant of his inheritance? He **will** certainly not hold onto his **anger** forever, for he is delighting in **loving-kindness**. **(Micah 7:18)**
- Preserving **loving-kindness** for thousands, **pardoning error** and **transgression** and sin, but by no means will he **give exemption from punishment, bringing punishment** for the **error of fathers upon sons** and upon grandsons, upon the **third generation** and upon the **fourth generation**. **(Exodus 34:7)**

· If we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous so as to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (**1 John 1:9**)

· Yehowah is **slow** to **anger** and great in power, and by no **means will** Yehowah hold back from punishing. In destructive wind and in storm is his way, and the cloud mass is the powder of his feet. (**Nahum 1:3**)

· But according to your hardness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself on the day of wrath and of the revealing of God's righteous judgment. (**Romans 2:5**)

· Preserving **loving-kindness** for thousands, **pardoning error** and **transgression** and sin, but by no **means will** he **give exemption** from **punishment, bringing punishment** for the **error of fathers** upon sons and upon grandsons, upon the **third generation** and upon the **fourth generation**. (**Exodus 34:7**)

· Suppose the fifty righteous should be lacking five. Will you for the five bring the whole city to ruin? To this he said; I shall not bring it to ruin if I find there forty-five. (**Genesis 18:28**)

· As for those remaining among **you**, they **will** rot away because of their **error** in the lands of **YOUR** enemies. Yes, even because of the **errors** of their **fathers**, with them they **will** rot away. (**Leviticus 26:39**)

· Because it is Yehowah's word that he has despised and his commandment that he has broken, that soul should be cut off without fail. His own **error** is upon him. (**Numbers 15:31**)

· And now a sword **will** not depart from your own house to time indefinite, as a consequence of the fact that you despised me so that you took the wife of Uriah the Hittite to become your wife. (**2 Samuel 12:10**)

· So they refused to listen, and they did not remember your wonderful acts that you performed with them, but they hardened their neck and appointed a head to return to their servitude in Egypt. But you are a God of acts of forgiveness, gracious and merciful, **slow** to **anger** and **abundant** in **loving-kindness**, and you did not leave them. (**Nehemiah 9:17**)

· If I have sinned and you have kept watching me and of my **error** you do not hold me innocent. (**Job 10:14**)

- Show me favor, O God, according to your **loving-kindness**. According to the abundance of your mercies wipe out my **transgressions**. (**Psalms 51:1**)
- But he was merciful, he would cover the **error** and not bring ruin. And many times he made his **anger** turn back, and he would not rouse up all his rage. (**Psalms 78:38**)
- But you, O Yehowah, are a God merciful and gracious, **slow to anger** and **abundant in loving-kindness** and trueness. (**Psalms 86:15**)
- And he would remember concerning them his covenant, and he would feel regret according to the abundance of his grand **loving-kindness**. (**Psalms 106:45**)
- Yehowah is gracious and merciful, **slow to anger** and great in **loving-kindness**. (**Psalms 145:8**)
- Let the wicked man leave his way, and the harmful man his thoughts, and let him return to Yehowah, who **will** have mercy upon him, and to our God, for he **will** forgive in a large way. (**Isaiah 55:7**)
- The One exercising **loving-kindness** toward thousands, and repaying the **error** of the **fathers** into the bosom of their **sons** after them, the true God, the great One, the mighty One, Yehowah of armies being his name. (**Jeremiah 32:18**)
- To Yehowah our God belong the mercies and the acts of forgiveness, for we have rebelled against him. (**Daniel 9:9**)
- And rip apart **YOUR** hearts, and not **YOUR** garments, and come back to Yehowah **YOUR** God, for he is gracious and merciful, **slow to anger** and **abundant in loving-kindness**, and he **will** certainly feel regret on account of the calamity. (**Joel 2:13**)
