

YEHOWAH - THE GOD OF ABRAHAM

Matthew 22:32· I am the God of Abraham and the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob? He is the God, not of the dead, but of the living.

- And he went on to say; I **am** the **God** of your father, the **God** of **Abraham**, the **God** of **Isaac** and the **God** of **Jacob**. Then Moses concealed his face, because he was afraid to look at the **true God**. (**Exodus 3:6**)
- The **God** of **Abraham** and of **Isaac** and of **Jacob**, the **God** of our forefathers, has glorified his Servant, **Jesus**, whom **YOU**, for **YOUR** part, delivered up and disowned before Pilate's face, when he had decided to release him. (**Acts of Apostles 3:13**)
- But now they are reaching out for a better place, that is, one belonging to heaven. Hence **God** is not ashamed of them, to be called upon as their **God**, for he has made a city ready for them. (**Hebrews 11:16**)
- But that the **dead** are raised up even Moses disclosed, in the account about the thornbush, when he calls Yehowah the **God** of **Abraham** and **God** of **Isaac** and **God** of **Jacob**. (**Luke 20:37**)
- He is a **God**, not of the **dead**, but of the living, for they are all living to him. (**Luke 20:38**)
- Just as it is written: I have appointed you a father of many nations. This was in the sight of the One in whom he had faith, even of **God**, who makes the **dead** alive and calls the things that are not as though they were. (**Romans 4:17**)
- And he went on to say; Yehowah the **God** of my master **Abraham**, cause it to happen, please, before me this day and perform loving-kindness with my master **Abraham**. (**Genesis 24:12**)

- And Yehowah proceeded to appear to him during that night and to say; I **am** the **God** of **Abraham** your father. Do not be afraid, because I **am** with you, and I will bless you and multiply your seed on account of **Abraham** my servant. (**Genesis 26:24**)
- And he went on to say; I **am** the true **God**, the **God** of your father. Do not be afraid to go down to Egypt, for I shall constitute you there into a great nation. (**Genesis 46:3**)
- Thus Jacob finished giving commands to his sons. Then he gathered his feet up onto the couch and expired and was gathered to his people. (**Genesis 49:33**)
- Then **God** said once more to Moses; This is what you are to say to the sons of Israel, Yehowah the **God** of **YOUR** forefathers, the **God** of **Abraham**, the **God** of **Isaac** and the **God** of **Jacob**, has sent me to **YOU**. This is my name to time indefinite, and this is the memorial of me to generation after generation. (**Exodus 3:15**)
- And it came about at the time that the grain offering goes up that Elijah the prophet began to approach and say; O Yehowah, the **God** of **Abraham**, **Isaac** and **Israel**, today let it be known that you are **God** in **Israel** and I **am** your servant and it is by your word that I have done all these things. (**1 Kings 18:36**)
- Go back, and you must say to Hezekiah the leader of my people, This is what Yehowah the **God** of **David** your forefather has said; I have heard your prayer. I have seen your tears. Here I **am** healing you. On the third day you will go up to the house of Yehowah. (**2 Kings 20:5**)
- O cry out joyfully, **YOU** people, to **God** our strength, shout in triumph to the **God** of **Jacob**. (**Psalms 81:1**)
- And he went on to say to me; Prophecy over these bones, and you must say to them, O **YOU** dry bones, hear the word of Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 37:4**)
- He is a **God**, not of the **dead**, but of the living. **YOU** are much mistaken. (**Mark 12:27**)
- And a white robe was given to each of them, and they were told to rest a little while longer, until the number was filled also of their fellow slaves and their brothers who were about to be killed as they also had been. (**Revelation 6:11**)

- **And the fifth angel blew his trumpet. And I saw a star that had fallen from heaven to the earth, and the key of the pit of the abyss was given him. (Revelation 9:1)**
