

YEHOWAH - TRUE GOD - YOU WILL KNOW YEHOWAH IS THE TRUE GOD

~ **Moses** ... **Statement** ... **Yehowah True God** - You will know Yehowah is the true God – one keeping covenant and loving-kindness toward those who love him to a thousand generations. (**Deuteronomy 7:9**) [25] - References

Deuteronomy 7:9· And you will know that Yehowah your God is the true God, the faithful God, keeping covenant and loving-kindness in the case of those who love him and those who keep his commandments to a thousand generations,

[25] - References

· And I will remember in their behalf the **covenant** of the ancestors whom I brought forth out of the land of Egypt under the eyes of the nations, in order to prove myself their **God**. I am Yehowah. (**Leviticus 26:45**)

· You, you have been shown, so as to **know** that **Yehowah** is the **true God**, there is no other besides him. (**Deuteronomy 4:35**)

· The **true God** is for us a **God** of saving acts, and to **Yehowah** the Sovereign Lord belong the ways out from death. (**Psalms 68:20**)

· This is what **Yehowah**, the Repurchaser of Israel, his Holy One, has said to him that is despised in soul, to him that is detested by the nation, to the servant of rulers; Kings themselves will see and certainly rise up, and princes, and they will bow down, by reason of **Yehowah**, who is **faithful**, the Holy One of Israel, who chooses you. (**Isaiah 49:7**)

· No temptation has taken **you** except what is common to men. But **God** is **faithful**, and he will not let **you** be tempted beyond what **you** can bear, but along with the temptation he will also make the way out in order for **you** to be able to endure it. (**1 Corinthians 10:13**)

· But **God** can be relied upon that our speech addressed to **you** is not Yes and yet No. (**2 Corinthians 1:18**)

· By faith also Sarah herself received power to conceive seed, even when she was past the age limit, since she esteemed him **faithful** who had promised. (**Hebrews 11:11**)

- And I went on to say; Ah, **Yehowah** the **God** of the heavens, the **God** great and fear-inspiring, **keeping** the **covenant** and **loving-kindness** toward those loving him and **keeping** his **commandments**. (**Nehemiah 1:5**)
- And I began to pray to **Yehowah** my **God** and to make confession and to say; Ah **Yehowah** the **true God**, the great One and the fear-inspiring One, **keeping** the **covenant** and the **loving-kindness** to those loving him and to those **keeping** his **commandments**. (**Daniel 9:4**)
- Preserving **loving-kindness** for **thousands**, pardoning error and transgression and sin, but by no means will he give exemption from punishment, bringing punishment for the error of fathers upon sons and upon grandsons, upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation. (**Exodus 34:7**)
- But exercising **loving-kindness** toward the thousandth generation in the **case** of those who **love** me and **keep** my **commandments**. (**Deuteronomy 5:10**)
- And the rainbow must occur in the cloud, and I shall certainly see it to remember the **covenant** to time indefinite between **God** and every living soul among all flesh that is upon the earth. (**Genesis 9:16**)
- The Rock, perfect is his activity, for all his ways are justice. A **God** of faithfulness, with whom there is no injustice. Righteous and upright is he. (**Deuteronomy 32:4**)
- And he went on to say; O **Yehowah** the **God** of Israel, there is no **God** like you in the heavens above or on the earth beneath, **keeping** the **covenant** and the **loving-kindness** toward your servants who are walking before you with all their heart. (**1 Kings 8:23**)
- Remember his **covenant** even to time indefinite, the word that he commanded, to a **thousand generations**. (**1 Chronicles 16:15**)
- And you proceeded to constitute your people Israel as your people to time indefinite, and you yourself, O **Yehowah**, became their **God**. (**1 Chronicles 17:22**)
- And he went on to say; O **Yehowah** the **God** of Israel, there is no **God** like you in the heavens or on the earth, **keeping** the **covenant** and the **loving-kindness** toward your servants who are walking before you with all their heart. (**2 Chronicles 6:14**)
- And now, O our **God**, the **God** great, mighty and fear-inspiring, **keeping** the **covenant** and **loving-kindness**, do not let all the hardship

that has found us, our kings, our princes and our priests and our prophets and our forefathers and all your people from the days of the kings of Assyria down to this day, seem little before you. (**Nehemiah 9:32**)

- And you are righteous as regards all that has come upon us, for faithfully is how you have acted, but we are the ones that have done wickedly. (**Nehemiah 9:33**)

- For **Yehowah** is good, his **loving-kindness** is to time indefinite, and his faithfulness to generation after generation. (**Psalms 100:5**)

- Toward those **keeping** his **covenant** and toward those remembering his orders so as to carry them out. (**Psalms 103:18**)

- He has remembered his **covenant** even to time indefinite, the word that he commanded, to a **thousand generations**. (**Psalms 105:8**)

- Your faithfulness is for generation after generation. You have solidly fixed the earth, that it may **keep** standing. (**Psalms 119:90**)

- The Maker of heaven and earth, of the sea, and of all that is in them, the One **keeping** trueness to time indefinite. (**Psalms 146:6**)

- **God** is **faithful**, by whom **you** were called into a sharing with his Son Jesus Christ our Lord. (**1 Corinthians 1:9**)
