Yehowah took you to himself as his people' (1 Samuel 12:22) ^[26] -
References

1 Samuel 12:22 For Yehowah will not desert his people for the sake of his great name, because Yehowah has taken it upon himself to make **YOU** his people.

[26] - References

- And I shall indeed reside in the middle of the sons of Israel, and I shall not leave my **people** Israel. (1 Kings 6:13)
- For **Yehowah will** not forsake his **people**, nor **will** he leave his own inheritance. (Psalms 94:14)
- I ask, then, God did not reject his **people**, did he? Never may that happen! For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, of the tribe of Benjamin. (Romans 11:1)
- And the Canaanites and all the inhabitants of the land **will** hear of it, and they **will** certainly surround us and cut our **name** off from the earth, and what **will** you do for your **great** name? (Joshua 7:9)
- My soul he refreshes. He leads me in the tracks of righteousness for his name's **sake** (Psalms 23:3)
- And he proceeded to save them for the **sake** of his **name**, so as to **make** his mightiness known. (Psalms 106:8)
- Do not disrespect us for the **sake** of your **name**, do not despise your glorious throne. Remember, do not break your covenant with us. (Jeremiah 14:21)
- But I acted for the **sake** of my own **name** that it might not be profaned before the eyes of the nations, before whose eyes I had brought them forth. (Ezekiel 20:14)
- And now if **you will** strictly obey my voice and **will** indeed keep my covenant, then **you will** certainly become my special property out of all [other] **peoples**, because the whole earth belongs to me. (Exodus 19:5)

- It was not because of **YOUR** being the most populous of all the **peoples** that **Yehowah** showed affection for **YOU** so that he chose **YOU**, for **YOU** were the least of all the **peoples**. (**Deuteronomy 7:7**)
- For you are a holy **people** to **Yehowah** your God, and **Yehowah** **has** chosen you to become his **people**, a special property, out of all the **peoples** who are on the surface of the ground. (**Deuteronomy 14:2**)
- For Yehowah's share is his **people**, Jacob is the allotment that he inherits. (**Deuteronomy 32:9**)
- The **people** whom I have formed for myself, that they should recount the praise of me. (**Isaiah 43:21**)
- Were it not that I was afraid of vexation from the enemy, that their adversaries might misconstrue it, that they might say; Our hand **has** proved superior, and it was not **Yehowah** who worked all this out. (**Deuteronomy 32:27**)
- And I shall certainly defend this city to save it for my own **sake** and for the **sake** of David my servant. (**2 Kings 19:34**)
- And you proceeded to constitute your **people** Israel as your **people** to time indefinite, and you yourself, O **Yehowah**, became their God. (**1 Chronicles 17:22**)
- You, even you, in your abundant mercy did not leave them in the wilderness. The pillar of cloud itself did not depart from over them by day to lead them in the way, nor the pillar of fire by night to light up for them the way in which they should go. (**Nehemiah 9:19**)
- For if you are altogether silent at this time, relief and deliverance themselves **will** stand up for the Jews from another place, but as for you and your father's house, **you people will** perish. And who is there knowing whether it is for a time like this that you have attained to royal dignity? (**Esther 4:14**)
- And the Jews went striking down all their enemies with a slaughter by the sword and with a killing and destruction, and they went doing to those hating them according to their liking. (**Esther 9:5**)
- For it was not by their own sword that they took possession of the land, and their own arm was not what brought them salvation. For it was your right hand and your arm and the light of your face, because you took pleasure in them. (**Psalms 44:3**)

- Help us, O God of our salvation, for the **sake** of the glory of your **name**, and deliver us and cover over our sins on account of your **name**. (**Psalms 79:9**)
- Let Israel rejoice in its grand Maker, the sons of Zion, let them be joyful in their King. (**Psalms 149:2**)
- And I shall certainly defend this city to save it for my own **sake** and for the **sake** of David my servant. (**Isaiah 37:35**)
- For the **sake** of my **name** I shall check my anger, and for my praise I shall restrain myself toward you that there may be no cutting you off. (**Isaiah 48:9**)
- And I came passing along by you and got to see you, and, look! your time was the time for love's expressions. So I proceeded to spread my skirt over you and to cover your nakedness and to **make** a sworn statement to you and enter into a covenant with you, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah**, and so you became mine. (**Ezekiel 16:8**)
- And I went acting for the **sake** of my own **name** that it might not be profaned before the eyes of the nations in among whom they were, because I had made myself known to them before their eyes on bringing them forth from the land of Egypt. (**Ezekiel 20:9**)
