~ **Moses** ... **Statement** ... **Yehowah** - You are a holy people to Yehowah your God, Yehowah has chosen you to become his people, a special property out of all peoples' (**Deuteronomy 7:6**) [\[31\] - References](#)

**Deuteronomy 7:6** For you are a holy people to Yehowah your God. It is you Yehowah your God has chosen to become his people, a special property, out of all the peoples that are on the surface of the ground.

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- And **you** yourselves will **become** to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation. These are the words that you are to say to the sons of Israel. (**Exodus 19:6**)
- For you are a holy **people** to **Yehowah** your **God**, and **Yehowah** has chosen you to **become** his **people**, a **special property**, out of all the **peoples** who are on the **surface** of the **ground**. (**Deuteronomy 14:2**)
- Israel was something holy to **Yehowah**, the first yield to Him. Any persons devouring him would make themselves guilty. Calamity itself would come upon them, was the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 2:3**)
- And now if **you** will strictly obey my voice and will indeed keep my covenant, then **you** will certainly **become** my **special property** out of all **other peoples**, because the whole earth belongs to me. (**Exodus 19:5**)
- For **Yah** has chosen even Jacob for himself, Israel for his **special property**. (**Psalms 135:4**)
- **You people** only have I known **out** of all the families of the **ground**. That is why I shall hold an accounting against **you** for all **your** errors. (**Amos 3:2**)
- And they will certainly **become** mine, **Yehowah** of armies has said, at the day when I am producing a **special property**. And I will show compassion upon them, just as a man shows compassion upon his son who is serving him. (**Malachi 3:17**)

- And you must say to Pharaoh; This is what **Yehowah** has said; Israel is my son, my firstborn. (**Exodus 4:22**)
- And I shall certainly take **you** to me as a **people**, and I shall indeed prove to be **God** to **you**, and **you** will certainly know that I am **Yehowah** **YOUR** **God** who is bringing **you out** from under the burdens of Egypt. (**Exodus 6:7**)
- For I am **Yehowah** who is leading **you up out** of the land of Egypt to prove myself **God** to **you**, and **you** must prove yourselves holy, because I am holy. (**Leviticus 11:45**)
- And **you** must prove yourselves holy to me, because I **Yehowah** am holy, and I am proceeding to divide **you** off from the **peoples** to **become** mine. (**Leviticus 20:26**)
- And that he will put you high above all the other nations that he **has** made, resulting in praise and reputation and beauty, while you prove yourself a **people** holy to **Yehowah** your **God**, just as he **has** promised. (**Deuteronomy 26:19**)
- **Yehowah** will establish you as a holy **people** to himself, just as he swore to you, because you continue to keep the commandments of **Yehowah** your **God**, and you have walked in his ways. (**Deuteronomy 28:9**)
- For the purpose of establishing you today as his **people** and that he may prove himself your **God**, just as he **has** promised you and just as he **has** sworn to your forefathers Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. (**Deuteronomy 29:13**)
- For Yehowah's share is his **people**, Jacob is the allotment that he inherits. (**Deuteronomy 32:9**)
- And we must **become**, we also, like all the nations, and our king must judge us and go **out** before us and fight our battles. (**1 Samuel 8:20**)
- And your servant is in the middle of your **people** whom you have **chosen**, a multitudinous **people** that cannot be numbered or counted for multitude. (**1 Kings 3:8**)
- And you proceeded to constitute your **people** Israel as your **people** to time indefinite, and you yourself, O **Yehowah**, became their **God**. (**1 Chronicles 17:22**)
- For they have accepted some of their daughters for themselves and for their sons, and they, the holy seed, have **become** mingled with

the **peoples** of the lands, and the hand of the princes and the deputy rulers **has** proved to be foremost in this unfaithfulness. (**Ezra 9:2**)

· He will choose for us our inheritance, the pride of Jacob, whom he **has** loved. (**Psalms 47:4**)

· He **has** not done that way to any other nation, and as for his judicial decisions, they have not known them. Praise Yah, **you people!** (**Psalms 147:20**)

· Pay attention to me, O my **people**, and you national group of mine, to me give ear. For from me a Law itself will go forth, and my judicial decision I shall cause to repose even as a light to the **peoples**. (**Isaiah 51:4**)

· For a little while your holy **people** had possession. Our own adversaries have stamped down your sanctuary. (**Isaiah 63:18**)

· Do not be indignant, O **Yehowah**, to the extreme, and do not forever remember our error. Look, now, please, we are all your **people**. (**Isaiah 64:9**)

· And you must say to them; This is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah has** said; In the day of my choosing Israel, I also proceeded to lift up my hand in an oath to the seed of the house of Jacob and to make myself known to them in the land of Egypt. Yes, I proceeded to lift up my hand in an oath to them, saying; I am **Yehowah YOUR** God. (**Ezekiel 20:5**)

· I have loved **you people**, **Yehowah has** said. And **you** have said; In what way have you loved us? Was not Esau the brother of Jacob? is the utterance of **Yehowah**. But I loved Jacob. (**Malachi 1:2**)

· Observe intently the birds of heaven, because they do not sow seed or reap or gather into storehouses, still **YOUR** heavenly Father feeds them. Are **you** not worth more than they are? (**Matthew 6:26**)

· Blessed be **Yehowah** the **God** of Israel, because he **has** turned his attention and performed deliverance toward his **people**. (**Luke 1:68**)

· The **God** of this **people** Israel chose our forefathers, and he exalted the **people** during their alien residence in the land of Egypt and brought them **out** of it with an uplifted arm. (**Acts of Apostles 13:17**)

· Who gave himself for us that he might deliver us from every sort of Lawlessness and cleanse for himself a **people** peculiarly his own, zealous for fine works. (**Titus 2:14**)

- But **you** are a **chosen** race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a **people** for **special** possession, that **you** should declare abroad the excellencies of the one that called **you out** of darkness into his wonderful light. (**1 Peter 2:9**)
