~ **Moses** ... **Statement** ... **Yehowah** - You must apply Yehowah's words to your heart and soul and bind them upon your hand and they must serve as a frontlet band upon your eyes. **(Deuteronomy 11:18)**

**Deuteronomy 11:18**·· And **YOU** must apply these words of mine to **YOUR** heart and **YOUR** soul and bind them as a sign upon **YOUR** hand, and they must serve as a frontlet band between **YOUR** eyes.

- And these **words** that I am commanding you today **must** prove to be on your **heart**. **(Deuteronomy 6:6)**
- He Law of his God is in his **heart**, his steps will not wobble. **(Psalms 37:31)**
- Tie them upon your fingers, and write them upon the tablet of your **heart**. **(Proverbs 7:3)**
- Listen to me, **YOU** the ones knowing righteousness, the people in whose **heart** is my Law. Do not be afraid of the reproach of mortal men, and do not be struck with terror just because of their abusive **words**. **(Isaiah 51:7)**
- And it **must serve** for you as a **sign** upon your **hand** and as a memorial **between** your **eyes**, in order, that Yehowah's Law may prove to be in your mouth, because by a strong **hand** Yehowah brought you out of Egypt. **(Exodus 13:9)**
- And it **must serve** as a **sign** upon your **hand** and as a **frontlet band between** your **eyes**, because by strength of **hand** Yehowah brought us out of Egypt. **(Exodus 13:16)**
- And you **must tie** them as a **sign** upon your **hand**, and they **must serve** as a **frontlet band between** your **eyes**. **(Deuteronomy 6:8)**
- And it **must serve** as a fringed edge for **YOU**, and **YOU must** see it and remember all the commandments of Yehowah and do them, and **YOU must** not go about following **YOUR hearts** and **YOUR eyes**, which **YOU** are following in immoral intercourse. **(Numbers 15:39)**

- And it **must** continue with him, and he **must** read in it all the days of his life, in order, that he may learn to fear Yehowah his God so as to keep all the **words** of this Law and these regulations by doing them. (**Deuteronomy 17:19**)

- He went on to say to them; Apply **YOUR hearts** to all the **words** that I am speaking in warning to **YOU** today, that **YOU** may command **YOUR** sons to take care to do all the **words** of this Law. (**Deuteronomy 32:46**)

- My son, keep my sayings, and may you treasure up my own commandments with you. (**Proverbs 7:1**)
