- **And it came about following such things that Absalom proceeded to have a chariot made for himself, with horses and with fifty men running before him. (2 Samuel 15:1)**
- **All the while Adonijah the son of Haggith was lifting himself up, saying; I myself am going to rule as king! And he proceeded to have a chariot made for himself with horsemen and fifty men running before him. (1 Kings 1:5)**
- **Anyone slandering his companion in secrecy, him I silence. Anyone of haughty eyes and of arrogant heart, him I cannot endure. (Psalms 101:5)**
- **Everyone that is proud in heart is something detestable to Yehowah. Hand may join to hand, yet one will not be free from punishment. (Proverbs 16:5)**
- **For if anyone thinks he is something when he is nothing, he is deceiving his own mind. (Galatians 6:3)**
- **False lips are something detestable to Yehowah, but those acting in faithfulness are a pleasure to him. (Proverbs 12:22)**
- **Fornicators, men who lie with males, kidnappers, liars, false swearers, and whatever other thing is in opposition to the healthful teaching (1 Timothy 1:10)**
- **But as for the cowards and those without faith and those who are disgusting in their filth and murderers and fornicators and those practicing spiritism and idolaters and all the liars, their portion will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulphur. This means the second death. (Revelation 21:8)**

- At this he said; What have you done? Listen! Your brother's **blood** is crying out to me from the ground. (**Genesis 4:10**)
- Anyone **shedding** man's **blood**, by man will his own **blood** be shed, for in God's image he made man. (**Genesis 9:6**)
- And **you** must take no ransom for the soul of a murderer who is deserving to die, for without fail he should be put to death. (**Numbers 35:31**)
- Cursed is the one who accepts a bribe to strike a soul fatally, when it is **innocent** blood. And all the people must say, Amen! (**Deuteronomy 27:25**)
- When the words of Esau her older son were told to Rebekah, she at once sent and called Jacob her younger son and said to him; Look! Esau your brother is comforting himself in regard to you, to kill you. (**Genesis 27:42**)
- Well, they caught sight of him from a distance, and before he could get close by them they began plotting cunningly against him to put him to death. (**Genesis 37:18**)
- And Reuben went on to say to them; Do not spill **blood**. Pitch him into this water-pit which is in the wilderness and do not lay a violent hand upon him. His purpose was to deliver him out of their hand in order to return him to his father. (**Genesis 37:22**)
- You must not go around among your people for the sake of slandering. You must not stand up against your fellow's **blood**. I am Yehowah. (**Leviticus 19:16**)
- That no **innocent blood** may be spilled in the midst of your land that Yehowah your God is giving you as an inheritance, and no bloodguilt has to be upon you. (**Deuteronomy 19:10**)
- This is what we shall do to them while letting them live, that no indignation may come upon us over the oath that we have sworn to them. (**Joshua 9:20**)
- To this he said; All is well. My master himself has sent me, saying; Look! Just now there have come to me two young men from the mountainous region of Ephraim from the sons of the prophets. Do give them, please, a talent of silver and two changes of garments. (**2 Kings 5:22**)
- And there was also **innocent blood** that Manasseh shed in very great quantity, until he had filled Jerusalem from end to end, besides

his sin with which he caused Judah to sin by doing what was bad in the **eyes** of Yehowah. (**2 Kings 21:16**)

• And now take for yourselves seven bulls and seven rams and go to my servant Job, and **you** men must offer up a burnt sacrifice in **YOUR** own behalf, and Job my servant will himself pray for **YOU**. His face only I shall accept so as not to commit disgraceful folly with **YOU**, for **YOU** have not spoken concerning me what is truthful, as has my servant Job. (**Job 42:8**)

• You will destroy those speaking a lie. A man of bloodshed and deception Yehowah detests. (**Psalms 5:6**)

• Yehowah himself examines the righteous one as well as the wicked one, and anyone loving violence His soul certainly hates. (**Psalms 11:5**)

• Because the afflicted people you yourself will save, but the haughty **eyes** you will abase. (**Psalms 18:27**)

• Indeed they give advice so as to allure from one's own dignity, they take pleasure in a lie. With their mouth they bless, but inside themselves they call down evil. (**Psalms 62:4**)

• For the mouth of the wicked one and the mouth of deception have opened against me. They have spoken about me with the **tongue** of falsehood. (**Psalms 109:2**)

• O Yehowah, my heart has not been haughty, nor have my **eyes** been lofty, nor have I walked in things too great, nor in things too wonderful for me. (**Psalms 131:1**)

• For their feet are those that run to sheer badness, and they keep hastening to shed **blood**. (**Proverbs 1:16**)

• For the devious person is a detestable thing to Yehowah, but His intimacy is with the upright ones. (**Proverbs 3:32**)

• Haughty **eyes** and an arrogant heart, the lamp of the wicked ones, are sin. (**Proverbs 21:4**)

• There is a generation whose **eyes** have become O how lofty! and whose beaming **eyes** are lifted up. (**Proverbs 30:13**)

• Whom have you taunted and spoken of abusively? And against whom have you lifted up your voice and do you raise your **eyes** on high? It is against the Holy One of Israel! (**Isaiah 37:23**)

· Only **YOU** should by all means know that, if **YOU** are putting me to death, it is **innocent blood** that **YOU** are putting upon yourselves and upon this city and upon her inhabitants, for in truth Yehowah did send me to **YOU** to speak in **YOUR** ears all these words.
