- And too this is what the king said; Blessed be **Yehowah** the **God** of **Israel**, who **has** today given one to sit upon my throne, with my own eyes seeing it! (1 Kings 1:48)
- Blessed be **Yehowah** the **God** of **Israel** from time indefinite even to time indefinite. Amen and Amen. (Psalms 41:13)
- Blessed be **Yehowah God**, Israel's **God**, who alone is doing wonderful works. (Psalms 72:18)
- Blessed be **Yehowah** the **God** of **Israel** from time indefinite even to time indefinite, and all the **people** must say; Amen. Praise Yah, **you people!** (Psalms 106:48)
- He **has** sent redemption itself to his **people**. To time indefinite he **has** commanded his covenant. His name is holy and fear-inspiring. (Psalms 111:9)
- Now fear seized them all, and they began to glorify **God**, saying; A great prophet **has** been raised up among us, and, God **has turned** his **attention** to his people. (Luke 7:16)
- For you are a holy **people** to **Yehowah** your **God**. It is you **Yehowah** your **God** **has** chosen to become his **people**, a special property, out of all the **peoples** that are on the surface of the ground. (Deuteronomy 7:6)
- For Yah **has** chosen even Jacob for himself, **Israel** for his special property. (Psalms 135:4)
- And he added; Blessed be **Yehowah**, Shem's **God**, and let Canaan become a slave to him. (Genesis 9:26)

- And say; Blessed be **Yehowah** the **God** of my master Abraham, who **has** not left his loving-kindness and his trustworthiness **toward** my master. I being on the way, **Yehowah has** led me to the house of the brothers of my master. (**Genesis 24:27**)
- And I proceeded to bow down and prostrate myself before **Yehowah** and bless **Yehowah** the **God** of my master Abraham, who had led me in the true way to take the daughter of the brother of my master for his son. (**Genesis 24:48**)
- You go, and you must gather the older men of **Israel**, and you must say to them, Yehowah the **God** of **YOUR** forefathers **has** appeared to me, the **God** of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, saying; I will without fail give **attention** to **you** and to what is being done to **you** in Egypt. (**Exodus 3:16**)
- And Moses was taking Joseph's bones with him, because he had made the sons of **Israel** solemnly swear, saying; God will without fail turn his **attention** to **you**, and **you** must take my bones up out of here with **you**. (**Exodus 13:19**)
- Consequently Jethro said; Blessed be **Yehowah**, who **has** delivered **you** from the hand of Egypt and from the hand of Pharaoh, and who **has** delivered the **people** from under the hand of Egypt. (**Exodus 18:10**)
- And the women began to say to Naomi; Blessed be **Yehowah**, who **has** not let a repurchaser fail for you today, that his name may be proclaimed in **Israel**. (**Ruth 4:14**)
- And he went on to say; Blessed is **Yehowah** the **God** of **Israel**, who spoke by his own mouth with David my father, and by his own hand **has** given fulfillment, saying; (**1 Kings 8:15**)
- You will conceal them in the secret place of your person from the banding together of men. You will hide them in your booth from the quarreling of tongues. (**Psalms 31:20**)
- Let the reclaimed ones of **Yehowah** say so, whom he **has** reclaimed from the hand of the adversary. (**Psalms 107:2**)
- O bless **Yehowah**, all **you** servants of **Yehowah**, **you** who are standing in the house of **Yehowah** during the nights. (**Psalms 134:1**)
- And it must become a region for the remaining ones of the house of Judah. Upon them they will feed. In the houses of Ashkelon, in the evening, they will lie stretched out. For **Yehowah** their **God** will turn

his **attention** to them and certainly gather back the captive ones of them. (**Zephaniah 2:7**)

· Against the shepherds my anger **has** grown hot, and against the goatlike leaders I shall hold an accounting, for **Yehowah** of armies **has turned** his **attention** to his drove, the house of Judah, and **has** made them like his horse of dignity in the battle. (**Zechariah 10:3**)
