

ZECHARIAH - WHY ARE YOU OVERSTEPPING THE COMMANDMENTS

~ **Yehowah** ... **Command** ... **Zechariah** - Why are you overstepping the commandments of Yehowah, you will not succeed, be you left Yehowah he will leave you' (2 Chronicles 24:20) [\[22\] - References](#)

2 Chronicles 24:20 And God's spirit itself enveloped Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, so that he stood up above the people and said to them; **This is what the true God has said; Why are you overstepping the commandments of Yehowah, so that you cannot prove successful? Because you have left Yehowah, he will, in turn, leave you.**

- Then **Yehowah** came down in a cloud and spoke to him and took away some of the **spirit** that was upon him and put it upon each of the seventy older men. And it came about that as soon as the **spirit** settled down upon them, then they proceeded to act as prophets, but they did not do it again. (**Numbers 11:25**)
- Now for Azariah the **son** of Oded, the **spirit** of **God** came to be upon him. (**2 Chronicles 15:1**)
- Now as for Jahaziel the **son** of **Zechariah** the **son** of Benaiah the **son** of Jeiel the **son** of Mattaniah the Levite of the **sons** of Asaph, the **spirit** of **Yehowah** came to be upon him in the middle of the congregation. (**2 Chronicles 20:14**)
- For prophecy was at no time brought by man's **will**, but men spoke from **God** as they were borne along by Holy Spirit. (**2 Peter 1:21**)
- And Yehowah's **spirit enveloped** Gideon so that he went blowing the horn, and the Abi-ezrites got to be called together after him. (**Judges 6:34**)
- And **spirit** itself **enveloped** Amasai, the head of the thirty; Yours we are, O David, and with you we are, O **son** of Jesse. Peace, peace be yours, and peace to the one helping you, for your **God has** helped you. So David received them and put them among the heads of the troops. (**1 Chronicles 12:18**)

- From the blood of Abel down to the blood of **Zechariah**, who was slain between the altar and the house. Yes, I tell **you**, it **will** be required from this generation. (**Luke 11:51**)
- Then they brought the king's **son** out and put upon him the diadem and the Testimony and made him king, and so **Jehoiada** and his **sons** anointed him and **said**; Let the king live! (**2 Chronicles 23:11**)
- But Moses **said**; Why is it that **you** are passing beyond the order of **Yehowah**? But that **will** not succeed. (**Numbers 14:41**)
- At this Samuel **said** to Saul; You **have** acted foolishly. You **have** not kept the commandment of **Yehowah** your **God** that he commanded you, because, if you had, **Yehowah** would **have** made your kingdom firm over Israel to time indefinite. (**1 Samuel 13:13**)
- But they kept refusing to pay attention, and they kept giving a stubborn shoulder, and their ears they made too unresponsive to hear. (**Zechariah 7:11**)
- Then they **will have** to say; It was because they abandoned the covenant of **Yehowah** the **God** of their forefathers, which he concluded with them when he brought them out of the land of Egypt. (**Deuteronomy 29:25**)
- And you, Solomon my **son**, know the **God** of your father and serve him with a complete heart and with a delightful soul, for all hearts **Yehowah** is searching, and every inclination of the thoughts he is discerning. If you search for him, he **will** let himself be found by you, but if you **leave** him, he **will** cast you off forever. (**1 Chronicles 28:9**)
- Consequently he went out before Asa and **said** to him; Hear me, O Asa and all Judah and Benjamin! **Yehowah** is with **you** as long as **you prove** to be with him, and if **you** search for him, he **will** let himself be found by **you**, but if **you leave** him he **will leave you**. (**2 Chronicles 15:2**)
- Your badness should correct you, and your own acts of unfaithfulness should reprove you. Know, then, and see that your leaving **Yehowah** your **God** is something bad and bitter, and no dread of me **has** resulted to you, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord, **Yehowah** of armies. (**Jeremiah 2:19**)
- At that my anger **will** indeed blaze against them in that day, and I shall certainly forsake them and conceal my face from them, and they must become something to be consumed, and many calamities and distresses must come upon them, and they **will** be bound to say in that

day, Is it not because our **God** is not in our midst that these calamities **have** come upon us? (**Deuteronomy 31:17**)

- And when they went away from him, for they **left** him with many diseases, his own servants conspired against him because of the blood of the **sons** of **Jehoiada** the **priest**, and they got to kill him upon his own couch, so that he died. Then they buried him in the City of David, but they did not bury him in the burial places of the kings. (**2 Chronicles 24:25**)

- As for his **sons** and the abundance of the pronouncement against him and the founding of the house of the **true God**, there they are written in the exposition of the Book of the Kings. And Amaziah his **son** began to reign in place of him. (**2 Chronicles 24:27**)

- Consequently Yehowah's anger became hot against Amaziah, and so he sent a prophet to him and **said** to him; **Why have** you searched for the people's gods that did not deliver their own **people** out of your hand? (**2 Chronicles 25:15**)

- Due to the fact that they **have left** me and gone making sacrificial smoke to other gods, in order to offend me with all the doings of their hands and that my rage may pour forth upon this place and not be extinguished. (**2 Chronicles 34:25**)

- For you **have** forsaken your **people**, the house of Jacob. For they **have** become full of **what** is from the East, and they are practicers of magic like the Philistines, and with the children of foreigners they abound. (**Isaiah 2:6**)

- And Jeremiah proceeded to come from Topheth, to which **Yehowah** had sent him to prophesy, and to stand in the courtyard of the house of **Yehowah** and say to all the **people**. (**Jeremiah 19:14**)
