

ZEDEKIAH - CONTINUED TO DO BAD BEFORE GOD

~ **Men ... Unrighteous ... Zedekiah** - Continued to do what was bad before Yehowah, did not humble himself on account of Jeremiah's words to him. **(2 Chronicles 36:12)** [\[15\] - References](#)

2 Chronicles 36:12 And he continued to do what was bad in the eyes of Yehowah his God. He did not humble himself on account of Jeremiah the prophet at the order of Yehowah.

- And he proceeded to do **what** was **bad** in Yehowah's **eyes**, according to the detestable things of the nations that **Yehowah** had driven out from before the sons of Israel. **(2 Kings 21:2)**
- And he began to do **what** was **bad** in Yehowah's **eyes**, according to all that forefathers of his had done. **(2 Kings 23:32)**
- So Moses and Aaron went in to Pharaoh and said to him; This is **what Yehowah** the **God** of the Hebrews has said; How long must you refuse to submit yourself to me? Send my people away that they may serve me. **(Exodus 10:3)**
- However, Hezekiah humbled himself for the haughtiness of his heart, he and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and Yehowah's indignation did not come upon them in the days of Hezekiah. **(2 Chronicles 32:26)**
- And as for you, his son Belshazzar, you have not humbled your heart, although you knew all this. **(Daniel 5:22)**
- Humble yourselves in the **eyes** of **Yehowah**, and he will exalt **you**. **(James 4:10)**
- Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of **God**, that he may exalt **you** in due time. **(1 Peter 5:6)**
- The word that occurred to **Jeremiah** from **Yehowah**, when King Zedekiah sent to him Pashhur the son of Malchiah and Zephaniah the son of Maaseiah, the priest, saying; **(Jeremiah 21:1)**
- This is **what Yehowah** the **God** of Israel has said; Go, and you must say to Zedekiah the king of Judah, yes, you must say to him; This

is **what Yehowah** has said; Here I am giving this city into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he must burn it with fire. (**Jeremiah 34:2**)

- And King Zedekiah proceeded to send and take **Jeremiah** the **prophet** to him to the third entryway, which is in the house of **Yehowah**, and then the king said to **Jeremiah**; I am asking something of you. Do not hide from me anything. (**Jeremiah 38:14**)
- And he continued to do **what** was **bad** in Yehowah's **eyes**, according to all that Jehoiakim had done. (**2 Kings 24:19**)
- And he did not **humble** himself because of **Yehowah** the same as Manasseh his father humbled himself, for Amon was one that made guiltiness increase. (**2 Chronicles 33:23**)
- Even to Zedekiah the king of Judah I spoke according to all these words, saying; Bring **YOUR** necks under the yoke of the king of Babylon and serve him and his people and keep on living. (**Jeremiah 27:12**)
- But we shall positively do every word that has gone forth from our mouth, in **order** to make sacrificial smoke to the queen of the heavens' and to pour out to her drink offerings, just as we ourselves and our forefathers, our kings and our princes did in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem, when we used to be satisfied with bread and to be well off, and we did not see any calamity at all. (**Jeremiah 44:17**)
- And he continued to do **what** was **bad** in the **eyes** of **Yehowah**, according to all that Jehoiakim had done. (**Jeremiah 52:2**)
