~ **Men ... Unrighteous ... Zedekiah** - I will spread my hunting net over him and he will be caught and I will bring him to Babylon and put myself on judgment with him there respecting all his unfaithfulness which he acted against me' (**Ezekiel 17:20**) ^[12] - References

Ezekiel 17:20 And I will spread over him my net, and he will certainly be caught in my hunting net, and I will bring him to Babylon and put myself on judgment with him there respecting his unfaithfulness with which he acted against me.

- Then they seized the king and brought him up to the king of **Babylon** at Riblah, that they might pronounce a judicial decision upon him. (**2 Kings 25:6**)
- And Zedekiah's sons they slaughtered before his eyes, and Zedekiah's eyes he blinded, after which he bound him with copper fetters and brought him to **Babylon**. (**2 Kings 25:7**)
- Finally Yehowah brought **against** them the chiefs of the army that belonged to the king of Assyria, and so they captured Manasseh in the hollows and bound him with two fetters of copper and took him to **Babylon**. (**2 Chronicles 33:11**)
- And I shall **certainly spread** my **net** over him, and he must be **caught** in my **hunting net**, and I **will bring** him to **Babylon**, to the land of the Chaldeans, but it he **will** not see, and there he **will** die. (**Ezekiel 12:13**)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; I **will** also **spread** over you my **net** by means of a congregation of many peoples, and they **will certainly bring** you in my dragnet. (**Ezekiel 32:3**)
- Whichever way they go, I shall **spread** out over them my **net**. Like flying creatures of the heavens I shall **bring** them down. I shall discipline them in agreement with the report to their assembly. (**Hosea 7:12**)

- Just as I **put** myself on **judgment** with **YOUR** forefathers in the wilderness of the land of Egypt, so I shall **put** myself on **judgment** with **you**, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 20:36**)
- Hear, O **you** mountains, the legal case of Yehowah, also **you** durable objects, **you** foundations of the earth, for Yehowah has a legal case with his people, and it is with Israel that he **will** argue. (**Micah 6:2**)
- Your own sons have swooned away. They have lain down at the head of all the streets like the wild sheep in the **net**, as those who are full of the rage of Yehowah, the rebuke of your God. (**Isaiah 51:20**)
- And after that, is the utterance of Yehowah, I shall give Zedekiah the king of Judah and his servants and the people and those who are remaining over in this city from the pestilence, from the sword and from the famine, into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar the king of **Babylon**, even into the hand of their enemies and into the hand of those who are seeking for their soul, and he **will certainly** strike them with the edge of the sword. He **will** not feel sorry for them, nor **will** he show compassion or have any mercy. (**Jeremiah 21:7**)
- From the height he has sent fire into my bones, and he subdues each one. He has **spread** out a **net** for my feet. He has turned me backward. He has made me a woman laid desolate. All the day I am ill. (**Lamentations 1:13**)
- And nations all around from the jurisdictional districts began to set **against** him and got to **spread** over him their **net**. In their pit he was **caught**. (**Ezekiel 19:8**)
- And I **will bring you** into the wilderness of the peoples and **put** myself on **judgment** with **you** there face to face. (**Ezekiel 20:35**)
