- In that case you will prove successful if you take care to carry out the regulations and the judicial decisions that **Yehowah** commanded Moses respecting Israel. Be courageous and **strong**. Do not be afraid nor be terrified. (**1 Chronicles 22:13**)
- This is what **Yehowah** of **armies** has said; Let the hands of **you people** be **strong**, **you** who are hearing in these days these words from the mouth of the prophets, on the day on which the foundation of the house of **Yehowah** of **armies** was laid, for the temple to be built. (**Zechariah 8:9**)
- Stay awake, stand firm in the faith, carry on as men, grow mighty. (**1 Corinthians 16:13**)
- Finally, go on acquiring power in the Lord and in the mightiness of his strength. (**Ephesians 6:10**)
- Therefore they said to him; What shall we do to work the works of God? (**John 6:28**)
- Moreover, by night the Lord said to Paul through a vision; Have no fear, but keep on speaking and do not keep silent. (**Acts of Apostles 18:9**)
- Whatever **you** are doing, work at it whole-souled as to **Yehowah**, and not to men. (**Colossians 3:23**)
- To this he said; Because I shall prove to be with you, and this is the sign for you that it is I who have sent you; After you have brought

the **people** out of Egypt, **you people** will serve the **true** God on this mountain. (**Exodus 3:12**)

· In case you should pass through the waters, I will be with you, and through the rivers, they will not flood over you. In case you should walk through the fire, you will not be scorched, neither will the flame itself singe you. (**Isaiah 43:2**)

· What, then, shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who will be against us? (**Romans 8:31**)

· And Malchiram and Pedaiah and Shenazzar, Jekamiah, Hoshama and Nedabiah. (**1 Chronicles 3:18**)

· Those who came with Zerubbabel, Jeshua, Nehemiah, Seraiah, Reelaiah, Mordecai, Bilshan, Mispar, Bigvai, Rehum, Baanah. The number of the men of the **people** of Israel. (**Ezra 2:2**)

· And Haggai the prophet and Zechariah the grandson of Iddo the prophet prophesied to the Jews who were in Judah and in Jerusalem, in the name of the God of Israel who was over them. (**Ezra 5:1**)

· It was then that Zerubbabel the **son** of Shealtiel and Jeshua the **son** of **Jehozadak** got up and started to rebuild the house of God, which was in Jerusalem, and with them there were God's prophets giving them aid. (**Ezra 5:2**)

· Say to those who are anxious at heart; Be **strong**. Do not be afraid. Look! **YOUR** own God will come with vengeance itself, God even with a repayment. He himself will come and save **you people**. (**Isaiah 35:4**)

· Wake up, wake up, put on your strength, O Zion! Put on your beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city! For no more will there come again into you the uncircumcised and unclean one. (**Isaiah 52:1**)

· Then he said; Do not be afraid, O very desirable man. May you have peace. Be **strong**, yes, be strong. And as soon as he spoke with me I exerted my strength and finally said; Let my lord speak, because you have strengthened me. (**Daniel 10:19**)

· Accordingly he said; These are the two anointed ones who are standing alongside the Lord of the whole earth. (**Zechariah 4:14**)

· And you must take silver and gold and make a grand crown and put it upon the head of **Joshua** the **son** of **Jehozadak** the **High Priest**. (**Zechariah 6:11**)
