Lamentations 1:4 The ways of Zion are mourning, because there are none coming to the festival. All her gates are laid desolate, her priests are sighing. Her virgins are grief-stricken, and she herself has bitterness.

- And he treats his booth violently like that in a garden. He **has** brought his **festival** to ruin. Yehowah **has** caused to be forgotten in **Zion festival** and Sabbath, and in his angry denunciation he shows no respect for king and priest. (**Lamentations 2:6**)
- And I shall certainly cause all her exultation, her **festival**, her new moon and her Sabbath and her every festal season to cease. (**Hosea 2:11**)
- And I will turn **YOUR festivals** into **mourning** and all **YOUR** songs into a dirge, and I will bring up upon all hips sackcloth and upon every head baldness, and I will make the situation like the **mourning** for an only son, and the end result of it as a bitter day. (**Amos 8:10**)
- And her entrances will have to mourn and express sorrow, and she will certainly be cleaned out. She will sit down on the very earth. (**Isaiah 3:26**)
- Judah **has** gone **mourning**, and its very **gates** have faded away. They have become dejected to the earth, and even the outcry of Jerusalem **has** gone up. (**Jeremiah 14:2**)
- And it must occur in that day, is the utterance of Yehowah, that the heart of the king will perish, also the heart of the princes, and the **priests** will certainly be driven to astonishment, and the prophets themselves will be amazed. (**Jeremiah 4:9**)
- But hear, O **YOU** women, the word of Yehowah, and may **YOUR** ear take the word of his mouth. Then teach **YOUR** daughters a lamentation, and each woman her companion a dirge. (**Jeremiah 9:20**)

- Accordingly they said to me; Those left over, who have been left over from the captivity, there in the jurisdictional district, are in a very bad plight and in reproach, and the wall of Jerusalem is broken down, and its very **gates** have been burned with fire. (**Nehemiah 1:3**)
- And I proceeded to go out by the Valley Gate by night and in front of the Fountain of the Big Snake and to the Gate of the Ash-heaps, and I was constantly examining the walls of Jerusalem, how they were broken down and the **gates** of it had been eaten up by fire. (**Nehemiah 2:13**)
- The land **has** gone to **mourning**, **has** faded away. The productive land **has** withered, **has** faded away. The high ones of the people of the land have withered. (**Isaiah 24:4**)
- In the city an astonishing condition **has** been left behind, the gate **has** been crushed to a mere rubble heap. (**Isaiah 24:12**)
- And I have to make things tight for Ariel, and there must come to be **mourning** and lamentation, and she must become to me as the altar hearth of God. (**Isaiah 29:2**)
- The highways have been made **desolate**, the one passing over the path **has** ceased. He **has** broken the covenant, he **has** contemned the cities, he **has** taken no account of mortal man. (**Isaiah 33:8**)
- I have seen his very ways, and I began to heal him and conduct him and make compensation with comfort to him and to his **mourning** ones. (**Isaiah 57:18**)
- Instead of your proving to be one left entirely and hated, with nobody passing through, I will even set you as a thing of pride to time indefinite, an exultation for generation after generation. (**Isaiah 60:15**)
- The older men of the daughter of **Zion** sit down on the earth, where they keep silence. They have brought up dust upon their head. They have girded on sackcloth. The **virgins** of Jerusalem have brought their head down to the very earth. (**Lamentations 2:10**)
- And I will bring in the worst ones of the nations, and they will certainly take possession of their houses, and I will cause the pride of the strong ones to cease, and their sanctuaries must be profaned. (**Ezekiel 7:24**)
- The ones **grief-stricken** in absence from your festal season I shall certainly gather together, absent from you they happened to be, because of bearing reproach on her account. (**Zephaniah 3:18**)
