

James 1:22~ However, become doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves with false reasoning.

1· How then can anointed Christians accept with mildness this implanting of the word of God into their lives? They must do so by putting it into practice, forming good habits of study and preaching, and fine works in behalf of others.

[Question] What must anointed Christians become in life, and how can they best accomplish this implanting of the word of God?

2· The knowledge of the Bible is useless unless we put it into practice, and we would only be deceiving ourselves if we do not put into practice what it teaches us. It is not enough to say that; I have read the Bible. We must actually live the Bible for it is a commandment to life, living sacred pronouncements from our God.

[Question] Is just knowing what the Bible says of any value to us if we do not put it into practice?

[Question] What are the Bible's commands a commandment to?

3· And you must keep my statutes and my judicial decisions, which if a man will do, he must also live by means of them. I am Yehowah. (Leviticus 18:5)

[Question] What did Yehowah God tell his people, that they must live by doing?

4· And you must keep the commandment and the regulations and the judicial decisions that I am commanding you today, by doing them. (Deuteronomy 7:11)

[Question] What did Moses tell the Israelite to keep doing?

5· In turn Samuel said; Does Yehowah have as much delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as in obeying the voice of Yehowah? Look! To obey is better than a sacrifice, to pay attention than the fat of rams. (1 Samuel 15:22)

[Question] What did Yehowah God show through Samuel that was better for them to do, than to sacrifice, once mistakes were made?

6· Not everyone saying to me; Lord, Lord, will enter into the kingdom of the heavens, but the one doing the will of my

Father who is in the heavens will. (Matthew 7:21)

[Question] Whom did Jesus Christ say would enter into the Kingdom of the heavens?

7· For Moses writes that the man that has done the righteousness of the Law, will live by it. (Romans 10:5)

[Question] What did Moses write, about who would live by means of the Law?

8· Little children, let no one mislead you! He who carries on righteousness is righteous, just as that one is righteous. (1 John 3:7)

[Question] What does the righteous one carry on infallibly?

9· But wicked men and impostors will advance from bad to worse, misleading and being misled. (2 Timothy 3:13)

[Question] What did Paul warn Timothy that wicked men would advance to in the Last Days?

10· For even we were once senseless, disobedient, being misled, being slaves to various desires and pleasures, carrying on in badness and envy, abhorrent, hating one another. (Titus 3:3)

[Question] How did many anointed Christians live before becoming such, and what drove them to do those acts?

11· Later Moses called the entire assembly of the sons of Israel together and said to them; These are the words that Yehowah has commanded, to do them. (Exodus 35:1)

[Question] Did Yehowah God command Moses just to tell the people the Law, or what?

12· These are the regulations and the judicial decisions that you should be careful to carry out in the land that Yehowah the God of your forefathers will certainly allow you to take possession of, all the days that you are alive on the soil. (Deuteronomy 12:1)

[Question] What way must they live their lives, in order to keep living in the Promised Land God gave them?

- 13· And Yehowah went on to say to me; Proclaim all these **words** in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem, saying; Hear, you people, the **words** of this covenant, and you must do them. (**Jeremiah 11:6**)

[Question] What words was Jeremiah told to give forth in all the cities of Judah and Jerusalem?

- 14· And the sons began to rebel against me. In my statutes they did not walk, and my judicial decisions they did not keep by doing them, which, should the man keep doing, he will also keep living by them. My Sabbaths they profaned. So I promised to pour out my rage upon them, in order to bring my anger to its finish upon them in the wilderness. (**Ezekiel 20:21**)

[Question] When calling his people to account through Ezekiel, what did Yehowah God point to as their failings?

- 15· A bribe they have taken in you for the purpose of shedding blood. Interest and usury you have taken, and you violently keep making gain of your companions with defrauding, and me you have forgotten, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 22:12**)

[Question] What then were some of the wrong practices that were then going on among them?

- 16· And, look! You are to them like a song of sensuous loves, like one with a pretty voice and playing a stringed instrument well. And they will certainly hear your **words**, but there are none doing them. (**Ezekiel 33:32**)

[Question] What did Yehowah God's prophets prove to be like toward his people in their mind's eye?

- 17· Why, then, do you call me; Lord! Lord! But do not do the things I say? (**Luke 6:46**)

[Question] What do many today say and call Jesus Christ, but how many actually live by what he taught?

- 18· Then that slave that understood the will of his master, but did not get ready or do in line with his will, will be beaten with many strokes. (**Luke 12:47**)

[Question] What will happen to the slave who understood his master but did not perform?

19· If you love me, you will observe my commandments. (John 14:15)

[Question] What does it mean to love Christ?

20· For the hearers of Law are not the ones righteous before God, but the doers of Law will be declared righteous. (Romans 2:13)

[Question] Will those readers of the Bible be declared righteous or those who live by its teachings?

21· Little children, let us love, neither in word nor with the tongue, but in deed and truth. (1 John 3:18)

[Question] How should little anointed Christian children love?

22· Happy is he who reads aloud and those who hear the words of this prophecy, and who observe the things written in it; for the appointed time is near. (Revelation 1:3)

[Question] Who does the Revelation account say will be happy?
