2· For what reason did we fast and you did not see, and did we afflict our soul and you would take no note? Indeed you people were finding delight in the very day of your fasting, when there were all your toilers that you kept driving to work. (**Isaiah 58:3**)

[Question] How does Yehowah God find fault with the form of fasting practiced by his people?

3· You do ask, and yet you do not **receive**, because you are asking for a wrong purpose, that you may expend it upon your cravings for sensual pleasure. (**James 4:3**)

[Question] Why do many not receive the things, that they are asking God for?
