

James 1:8~

**He is an indecisive<sup>1</sup> man, unsteady in all his ways.**

**Footnote: Literally, two-souled Greek, *di'psy-khos*; Latin, *du'plex a'ni-mo***

**1· Such a man is wishy-washy not knowing where he is going in life. He is unsteady in all his ways. Yehowah God himself is described as the rock, and this relates to his firm holding to principles of righteousness and goodness. He will only support men who want to be like him and who are themselves firm for righteous principles, and who are applying themselves to make progress in Christian living.**

**[Question]** How can we show the difference between Yehowah God and the man who doubts?

**[Question]** What then, must all anointed Christians be firm for, in thought and in practice?

**2· Draw close to God, and he will draw close to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you indecisive ones. (James 4:8)**

**[Question]** What does Yehowah God promise to those who draw close to him in faith?

**[Question]** What must they then do within themselves, to draw close to Yehowah God?

**3· Speaking about these things as he does also in all his letters. In them, however, are some things hard to understand, which the untaught and **unsteady** are twisting, as they do also the rest of the Scriptures, to their own destruction. (2 Peter 3:16)**

**[Question]** What did Peter state about the writings of Paul, and how people used them wrongly even in his day?
