

James 1:9~

But let the lowly brother exult over his exaltation.

1· Now referring back to his counsel to find joy in their suffering as anointed Christians, James shows that the lowly or poorer brother should exult over his exaltation, that of being selected to be a future son of God, his firstborn among men.

[Question] What does James now show, that the lowly brother has cause to do, and why?

2· You have met up with the one exulting and doing righteousness, those who keep remembering you in your own ways. Look! You yourself became indignant, while we kept sinning in them a long time, and should we be saved? (Isaiah 64:5)

[Question] Who came out to meet those who were doing righteousness within Israel in Isaiah's day?

3· Listen, my beloved brothers. God chose the ones who are poor respecting the world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom, which he promised to those who love him, did he not? (James 2:5)

[Question] What kinds of men did Yehowah God choose to be his anointed sons?
