- If, now, you practice carrying out the kingly Law according to the scripture: You must love your neighbor as yourself, You are doing quite well.
 - 1. James now shows that if they are following the kingly law, to love one's neighbor as oneself, then they are doing fine and pleasing God.

[Question] What Law should all men follow, and why is it called the kingly law?

2. The second, like it, is this, you must love your neighbor as yourself. (Matthew 22:39)

[Question] What is the second most important Law, within the Law Covenant given to Israel?

3. Love does not work evil to one's neighbor, therefore love is the Law's fulfillment. (Romans 13:10)

[Question] What does love not work toward one's neighbor?

[Question] What then, is the Law Covenant's fulfillment?

4. You must not take vengeance nor have a grudge against the sons of your people, and you must love your fellow as yourself. I am Yehowah. (Leviticus 19:18)

[Question] What must Yehowah's people not do or hold toward others?

[Question] How must they treat their fellow man?

5. The second is this, you must love your neighbor as yourself. There is no other commandment greater than these. (Mark 12:31)

[Question] What is the second most important commandment of God in the Law Covenant?

6. In answer he said; You must love Yehowah your God with your whole heart and with your whole soul and with your whole strength and with your whole mind, and, your neighbor as yourself. (Luke 10:27)

[Question] What two commandments really summarize all the teachings of the Law Covenant?

7. I am giving you a new commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you, that you also love one another. (John 13:34)

[Question] What new commandment did Jesus Christ give, and how is it new?

8. For the entire Law stands fulfilled in one saying, namely. You must love your neighbor as yourself. (Galatians 5:14)

[Question] What statement sums up much of the Law Covenant and its teachings?

9. But Timothy has just now come to us from you and given us the good news about your faithfulness and love, and that you continue having good remembrance of us always, yearning to see us, in the same way, indeed, as we also do you. (1 Thessalonians 3:6)

[Question] How did Paul and Timothy feel about their anointed Christian brothers?
