

James 5:19~ My brothers, if anyone among you is misled from the truth¹ and another turns him back.

Footnote: Literally, should be made to err

1· Now James returns to his earlier argument of helping one another through prayer, showing that one who turns another back from being misled away from the truth, and turns him back to Yehowah God, is doing a fine deed and will surely be repaid by God.

[Question] James now returns to what argument?

[Question] What comes forth to the man who lovingly turns another man back from his sin?

2· Moreover, if your brother commits a sin, go lay bare his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have gained your brother. (Matthew 18:15)

[Question] What are anointed Christians encouraged to do, if a brother sins against them?

3· Save them by snatching them out of the fire. But continue showing mercy to others, doing so with fear, while you hate even the inner garment that has been stained by the flesh. (Jude 1:23)

[Question] How should anointed Christians be helping one another get through their sins?
