1· Yehowah God is the giver of life and all that life entails. He wants for men to live and enjoy life's many blessings. Therefore the person, who like him, cares for the needs of others and turns back a sinner from the path of death, will save that person's soul from death, and will cover over many of his own sins as well, for this is a sacrifice, with which God is well pleased.

2· Brothers, even though a man takes some false step before he is aware of it, you who have spiritual qualifications try to readjust such a man in a spirit of mildness, as you each keep an eye on yourself, for fear you also may be tempted. (Galatians 6:1)

[Question] How should those who have spiritual qualifications treat those who may be erring through sin?

3· For you have delivered my soul from death. Have you not delivered my feet from stumbling? That I may walk about before God in the light of those alive. (Psalms 56:13)

[Question] How did the Psalmist feel about his God's loving-kindness?

4· For you have rescued my soul from death, my eye from tears, my foot from stumbling. (Psalms 116:8)

[Question] How did the Psalmist feel about Yehowah's care for him?

5· Pay constant attention to yourself and to your teaching. Stay by these things, for by doing this you will save both yourself, and those who listen to you. (1 Timothy 4:16)

[Question] What should anointed Christians pay constant attention to, and to what end?

- 6· **And he used to say to them; Why do you keep doing things like these? For the things I am hearing about you from all the people are bad. (1 Samuel 2:23)**

[Question] How did Samuel chastise his own sons, who did not imitate him?

- 7· **And blessed be your sensibleness, and blessed be you who have restrained me this day from entering into bloodguilt, and having my own hand come to my salvation. (1 Samuel 25:33)**

[Question] How did David feel when Abigail stopped his rush to judgment in the case of Nabal her husband?

- 8· **The mouth of the righteous one is a source of life, but as regards the mouth of the wicked ones, it covers up violence. (Proverbs 10:11)**

[Question] What is the mouth of the righteous ones?

[Question] How though, do the wicked ones cover over their sins?

- 9· **The fruitage of the righteous one is a tree of life, and he that is winning souls is wise. (Proverbs 11:30)**

[Question] What is the fruitage of the righteous ones, and is wisdom on their part?

- 10· **A true witness is delivering souls, but a deceitful one launches forth mere lies. (Proverbs 14:25)**

[Question] What does a true witness do, as opposed to a deceitful witness?

- 11· **And as for you, in case you have warned someone righteous that the righteous one should not sin, and he himself does not actually sin, he will without fail keep on living, because he had been warned, and you yourself will have delivered your own soul. (Ezekiel 3:21)**

[Question] What does the righteous one deliver, when he warns someone who is in a path of sin?

- 12· **The very Law of truth proved to be in his mouth, and there was no unrighteousness to be found on his lips. In peace and in uprightness he walked with me, and many were**

those whom he turned **back** from **error**. (**Malachi 2:6**)

[Question] What does the righteous one do, and how is this viewed by Yehowah God?

- 13·** Moreover, if your brother commits a sin, go lay bare his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have gained your brother. (**Matthew 18:15**)

[Question] Who should we make aware of a brother's sin, and under what circumstances?

- 14·** For, wife, how do you know but that you **will save** your husband? Or, husband, how do you know but that you **will save** your wife? (**1 Corinthians 7:16**)

[Question] How should husbands and wives feel about saving their partners?

- 15·** If anyone catches sight of his brother sinning a sin that does not incur **death**, he **will** ask, and he **will** give life to him, yes, to those not sinning so as to incur **death**. There is a sin that does incur **death**. It is concerning that sin that I do not tell him to make request. (**1 John 5:16**)
