

James 5:6~ You have condemned, you have murdered the righteous one. Is he not opposing you?¹

Footnote: Or, the righteous one; he is not opposing you

1· Such rich men have condemned righteous ones and even murdered them. Who could they be fooling, certainly not Yehowah God, who is directly opposed to all such behavior.

[Question] What have these rich men done to support their way, and are they fooling Yehowah God at all?

2· If it has to do with ridiculers, he himself will deride, but to the meek ones he will show favor. (Proverbs 3:34)

[Question] How does Yehowah treat ridiculers, also meek ones?

3· And now do not let my blood fall to the earth before the face of Yehowah, for the king of Israel has gone out to look for a single flea, just as one chases a partridge upon the mountains. (1 Samuel 26:20)

[Question] How did David feel when being chased by Saul?

4· Therefore haughtiness has served as a necklace to them, violence envelops them as a garment. (Psalms 73:6)

[Question] What bad qualities do they wear like garments?

5· Anyone pronouncing the wicked one **righteous and anyone pronouncing the **righteous** one wicked, even both of them are something detestable to Yehowah. (Proverbs 17:15)**

[Question] What does Yehowah not tolerate?

6· However, I say to you that everyone who continues wrathful with his brother will be accountable to the court of justice. Whoever addresses his brother with an unspeakable word of contempt will be accountable to the Supreme Court. Whoever says, you despicable fool! Will be liable to the fiery Gehenna. (Matthew 5:22)

[Question] What will the one continuing wrathful with a brother experience?
