- Beloved ones, I am writing **YOU**, not a new commandment, but an old commandment which **YOU** have had from the beginning. This old commandment is the word which **YOU** heard. (**1 John 2:7**)
- As for **YOU**, let that which **YOU** have heard from the beginning remain in **YOU**. If that which **YOU** have heard from the beginning remains in **YOU**, **YOU** will also abide in union with the Son and in union with the Father. (**1 John 2:24**)
- For this is the message which **YOU** have heard from the beginning, that we should have love for one another. (**1 John 3:11**)
- And **YOU**, in turn, are to bear witness, because **YOU** have been with me from when I began. (**John 15:27**)
- But as for us, we cannot stop speaking about the things we have seen and heard. (**Acts of Apostles 4:20**)
- So the Word became flesh and resided among us, and we had a view of his glory, a glory such as belongs to an only-begotten son from a father, and he was full of undeserved kindness and truth. (**John 1:14**)
- And as he was reclining with them at the meal he took the loaf, blessed it, broke it and began to hand it to them. (**Luke 24:30**)
- By means of him was life, and the life was the light of men. (**John 1:4**)
