

1 John 2:11 But he that hates his brother is in the darkness and is walking in the darkness, and he does not know where he is going, because the darkness has blinded his eyes.

- But if anyone walks in the night, he bumps against something, because the light is not in him. (**John 11:10**)
- For if these things are not present in anyone, he is blind, shutting his eyes to the light, and has become forgetful of his cleansing from his sins of long ago. (**2 Peter 1:9**)
- If anyone makes the statement; I love God, and yet is hating his brother, he is a liar. For he who does not love his brother, whom he has seen, cannot be loving God, whom he has not seen. (**1 John 4:20**)
- Jesus therefore said to them; The light will be among you a little while longer. Walk while you have the light, so that darkness does not overpower you, and he that walks in the darkness does not know where he is going. (**John 12:35**)
- However, Esau harbored animosity for Jacob on account of the blessing with which his father had blessed him, and Esau kept saying in his heart; The days of the period of mourning for my father are getting closer. After that I am going to kill Jacob my brother. (**Genesis 27:41**)
- They grope in darkness, where there is no light, that he may make them wander about like a drunken man. (**Job 12:25**)
- They have not known, and they do not understand, in darkness they keep walking about, all the foundations of the earth are made to totter. (**Psalms 82:5**)
- As regards anyone wise, his eyes are in his head, but the stupid one is walking on in sheer darkness. And I have come to know, I too, that there is one eventuality that eventuates to them all. (**Ecclesiastes 2:14**)
- We keep groping for the wall just like blind men, and like those without eyes we keep groping. We have stumbled at high noon just as in evening darkness, among the stout ones we are just like dead people. (**Isaiah 59:10**)
