- Beloved ones, now we are **children** of God, but as yet it has not been **made manifest** what we shall be. We do know that whenever he is **made manifest** we shall be like him, because we shall see him just as he is. (**1 John 3:2**)
- He that feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood **remains in union** with me, and I in **union** with him. (**John 6:56**)
- When the Christ, our life, is **made manifest**, then **you** also will be **made manifest** with him in glory. (**Colossians 3:4**)
