[14] - References:

- **God** set him forth as an offering for propitiation through faith in his blood. This was in order to exhibit his own righteousness, because he was forgiving the **sins** that occurred in the past while **God** was exercising forbearance. (**Romans 3:25**)
- And he is a **propitiatory sacrifice** for our **sins**, yet not for ours only but also for the whole world's. (**1 John 2:2**)
- Clear away the old leaven, that **you** may be a new lump, according as **you** are free from ferment. For, indeed, Christ our Passover has been sacrificed. (**1 Corinthians 5:7**)
- The one who did not know sin he made to be sin for us, that we might become God's righteousness by means of him. (**2 Corinthians 5:21**)
- Consequently he was obliged to become like his brothers in all **respects**, that he might become a merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to **God**, in order to offer **propitiatory sacrifice** for the **sins** of the people. (**Hebrews 2:17**)
- Otherwise, he would **have** to suffer often from the founding of the world. But now he has manifested himself once for all time at the conclusion of the systems of things to put sin away through the **sacrifice** of himself. (**Hebrews 9:26**)
- And he went on to say; Do not put out your hand against the boy and do not do anything at all to him, for now I do know that you are God-fearing in that you **have** not withheld your son, your only one, from me. (**Genesis 22:12**)
- And he must bring his guilt offering to Yehowah for his sin that he has committed, namely, a female from the flock, a female lamb or a female kid of the goats, for a sin offering, and the priest must make an atonement for him for his sin. (**Leviticus 5:6**)

- **There are seventy weeks that **have** been determined upon your people and upon your holy city, in order to terminate the transgression, and to finish off sin, and to make atonement for error, and to bring in righteousness for times indefinite, and to imprint a seal upon vision and prophet, and to anoint the Holy of Holies. (**Daniel 9:24**)**
- **For **God loved** the world so much that he gave his only-begotten **Son**, in order that everyone exercising faith in him might not be destroyed but **have** everlasting life. (**John 3:16**)**
- **But **God** recommends his own love to us in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. (**Romans 5:8**)**
- **Moreover, may our Lord Jesus Christ himself and **God** our Father, who **loved** us and gave everlasting comfort and good hope by means of undeserved kindness. (**2 Thessalonians 2:16**)**
- **But we behold Jesus, who has been made a little lower than angels, crowned with glory and honor for having suffered death, that he by God's undeserved kindness might taste death for every man. (**Hebrews 2:9**)**
- **As for us, we love, because he first **loved** us. (**1 John 4:19**)**
