

RECOLLECTION - THE LAW OF MOSES

Malachi 4:4 Remember, you people, the Law of Moses my servant with which I commanded him in Horeb concerning all Israel, even regulations and judicial decisions.

- See, I have taught you regulations and judicial decisions, just as Yehowah my God has commanded me, for you to do that way in the midst of the land to which you are going to take possession of it. (**Deuteronomy 4:5**)
- You yourself have commandingly given your orders to be carefully kept. (**Psalms 119:4**)
- He is telling his word to Jacob, this regulations and his judicial decisions to Israel. (**Psalms 147:19**)
- So they went marching from the mountain of Yehowah for a journey of three days, and the ark of Yehowah's covenant was marching before them for a journey of three days to search out a resting-place for them. (**Numbers 10:33**)
- Now this is the Law that Moses set before the sons of Israel. (**Deuteronomy 4:44**)
- And you stand here with me, and let me speak to you all the commandment and the regulations and the judicial decisions that you should teach to them and that they must do in the land that I am giving them to take possession of it. (**Deuteronomy 5:31**)
- After that Moses the servant of Yehowah died there in the land of Moab at the order of Yehowah. (**Deuteronomy 34:5**)
- Just as Moses the servant of Yehowah had commanded the sons of Israel, as it is written in the book of the Law of Moses; An altar of whole stones, upon which no iron tool has been wielded, and they went

offering up burnt offerings upon it to Yehowah and sacrificing communion sacrifices. (**Joshua 8:31**)

- So he rose up and ate and drank, and he kept going in the power of that nourishment for forty days and forty nights as far as the mountain of the true God, **Horeb**. (**1 Kings 19:8**)

- This is what Yehowah has said; Stand still in the ways, **YOU people**, and see, and ask for the roadways of long ago, where, now, the good way is, and walk in it, and find ease for **YOUR** souls. But they kept saying; We are not going to walk. (**Jeremiah 6:16**)
