Psalms 106:6 We have sinned just the same as our forefathers, we have done wrong, we have acted wickedly.

[19] - References

- And they will certainly confess their own error and the error of their fathers in their unfaithfulness when they behaved unfaithfully toward me, yes, even when they walked in opposition to me. (**Leviticus 26:40**)
- And they themselves, even our **forefathers, acted** presumptuously and proceeded to harden their neck, and they did not listen to your commandments. (**Nehemiah 9:16**)
- And they should not become like their **forefathers**, a generation stubborn and rebellious, a generation who had not prepared their heart and whose spirit was not trustworthy with God. (**Psalms 78:8**)
- And they indeed come to their senses in the land where they **have** been carried off captive, and they actually return and make request to you for favor in the land of their captors, saying; We **have sinned** and erred, we **have acted** wickedly. (**1 Kings 8:47**)
- And I went on to say; O my God, I do feel ashamed and embarrassed to raise my face to you, O my God, for our errors themselves **have** multiplied over our head and our guiltiness has grown great even to the heavens. (**Ezra 9:6**)
- We **have sinned** and done **wrong** and **acted wickedly** and rebelled, and there has been a turning aside from your commandments and from your judicial decisions. (**Daniel 9:5**)
- So they were collected together at Mizpah, and they went drawing water and pouring it out before Yehowah and kept a fast on that day. And they began saying there; We **have sinned** against Yehowah. And Samuel took up judging the sons of Israel in Mizpah. (**1 Samuel 7:6**)

- Go, inquire of Yehowah in my own behalf and in behalf of the people and in behalf of all Judah concerning the words of this book that has been found, for great is Yehowah's rage that has been set afire against us over the fact that our **forefathers** did not listen to the words of this book by doing according to all that is written concerning us. (**2 Kings 22:13**)
- And they indeed come to their senses in the land where they **have** been carried off captive, and they actually return and make request to you for favor in the land where they are captives, saying; We **have sinned**, we **have** erred and we **have acted** wickedly. (**2 Chronicles 6:37**)
- We **have** unquestionably **acted** corruptly against you and **have** not kept the commandments and the regulations and the judicial decisions that you gave in command to Moses your servant. (**Nehemiah 1:7**)
- And the seed of Israel proceeded to separate themselves from all the foreigners, and to stand and make confession of their own sins and the errors of their fathers. (**Nehemiah 9:2**)
- As for our kings, our princes, our priests and our **forefathers**, they **have** not performed your Law, nor paid attention to your commandments or to your testimonies with which you bore witness against them. (**Nehemiah 9:34**)
- We do acknowledge, O Yehowah, our wickedness, the error of our **forefathers**, for we **have sinned** against you. (**Jeremiah 14:20**)
- For the sons of Israel and the sons of Judah **have** proved to be mere doers of what was bad in my eyes, from their youth on up, for the sons of Israel are even offending me by the work of their hands, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 32:30**)
- But we shall positively do every word that has gone forth from our mouth, in order to make sacrificial smoke to the queen of the heavens' and to pour out to her drink offerings, **just** as we ourselves and our **forefathers**, our kings and our princes did in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem, when we used to be satisfied with bread and to be well off, and we did not see any calamity at all. (**Jeremiah 44:17**)
- And an army itself was gradually given over, together with the constant feature, because of transgression, and it kept throwing truth to the earth, and it **acted** and had success. (**Daniel 8:12**)

- O Yehowah, to us belongs the shame of face, to our kings, to our princes and to our **forefathers**, because we **have sinned** against you. (**Daniel 9:8**)
- O Yehowah, according to all your acts of righteousness, please, may your anger and your rage turn back from your city Jerusalem, your holy mountain, for, because of our sins and because of the errors of our **forefathers**, Jerusalem and your people are an object of reproach to all those round about us. (**Daniel 9:16**)
- Do not become like **YOUR** fathers to whom the former prophets called, saying; This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Return, please, from **YOUR** bad ways and from **YOUR** bad dealings. But they did not listen, and they paid no attention to me, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Zechariah 1:4**)
