

## RIGHTEOUS ONES - LIKE A CONFIDENT LION

**Proverbs 28:1** The wicked do flee when there is no pursuer, but the righteous are like a young lion that is confident.

• And I shall indeed set my face against **you**, and **you** will certainly be defeated before **YOUR** enemies, and those who hate **you** will just tread down upon **you**, and **you** will actually **flee** when no one is pursuing **you**. (**Leviticus 26:17**)

• And Yehowah himself had caused the camp of the Syrians to hear the sound of war chariots, the sound of horses, the sound of a great military force, so that they said to one another; Look! The king of Israel has hired against us the kings of the Hittites and the kings of Egypt to come against us! (**2 Kings 7:6**)

• There they were filled with a great dread, where there had proved to be no dread, for God himself will certainly scatter the bones of anyone camping against you. You will certainly put them to shame, for Yehowah himself has rejected them. (**Psalms 53:5**)

• And all these servants of yours will certainly come down to me and prostrate themselves to me, saying; Go, you and all the people who follow your steps. And after that I shall go out. With that he went out from Pharaoh in the heat of anger. (**Exodus 11:8**)

• And there were some of the Gadites that separated themselves to David's side at the place difficult to approach in the wilderness, valiant, mighty men, army men for the war, keeping the large shield and the lance ready, whose faces were the faces of **lions**, and they were like the gazelles upon the mountains for speed. (**1 Chronicles 12:8**)

• Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego answered, and they were saying to the king; O Nebuchadnezzar, we are under no necessity in this regard to say back a word to you. (**Daniel 3:16**)

- Now when they beheld the outspokenness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were men unlettered and ordinary, they got to wondering. And they began to recognize about them that they used to be with Jesus. (**Acts of Apostles 4:13**)
- Therefore they spent considerable time speaking with boldness by the authority of Yehowah, who bore witness to the word of his undeserved kindness by granting signs and portents to occur through their hands. (**Acts of Apostles 14:3**)
- But how, after we had first suffered and been insolently treated, just as **you** know, in Philippi, we mustered up boldness by means of our God to speak to **you** the Good News of God with a great deal of struggling. (**1 Thessalonians 2:2**)
- When the brothers of Joseph saw that their father was dead, they began to say; It may be that Joseph is harboring animosity against us and he will be sure to repay us for all the evil that we have rendered him. (**Genesis 50:15**)
- As for those remaining among **you**, I shall certainly bring timidity into their hearts in the lands of their enemies, and the sound of a leaf driven about will indeed chase them away, and they will actually **flee** as in flight from a sword and fall without anyone chasing. (**Leviticus 26:36**)
- And as to Gad he said; Blessed is the one widening the borders of Gad. As a **lion** he must reside, and he must tear the arm, yes, the crown of the head. (**Deuteronomy 33:20**)
- And David proceeded to say to Saul; Do not let the heart of any man collapse within him. Your servant himself will go and actually fight with this Philistine. (**1 Samuel 17:32**)
- And it occurred that the Philistine rose and kept coming and drawing nearer to meet David, and David began hurrying and running toward the battle line to meet the Philistine. (**1 Samuel 17:48**)
- And all those invited that were with Adonijah began to tremble and rise up and go each one on his own way. (**1 Kings 1:49**)
- There were six steps to the throne, and the throne had a round canopy behind it, and there were armrests on this side and on that side by the place of sitting, and two **lions** were standing beside the armrests. (**1 Kings 10:19**)

- Immediately they got up and went fleeing in the evening darkness and leaving their tents and their horses and their asses, the camp just as it was, and they kept fleeing for their soul. (**2 Kings 7:7**)
- And there were six steps to the throne, and there was a footstool in gold to the throne, they were attached, and there were armrests on this side and on that side by the place of sitting, and two lions were standing beside the armrests. (**2 Chronicles 9:18**)
- Then they stood up against Uzziah the king and said to him; It is not your business, O Uzziah, to burn incense to Yehowah, but it is the business of the priests the sons of Aaron, the ones sanctified, to burn incense. Go out from the sanctuary, for you have acted unfaithfully, and it is not for any glory to you on the part of Yehowah God. (**2 Chronicles 26:18**)
- But I said; Should a man like me run away? And who is there like me that could enter into the temple and live? I shall not enter! (**Nehemiah 6:11**)
- For Yehowah himself will prove to be, in effect, your confidence, and he will certainly keep your foot against capture. (**Proverbs 3:26**)
- And a report was made to the house of David, saying; Syria has leaned upon Ephraim. And his heart and the heart of his people began to quiver, like the quivering of the trees of the forest because of a wind. (**Isaiah 7:2**)
- And as for the likeness of their faces, the four of them had a man's face with a lion's face to the right, and the four of them had a bull's face on the left, the four of them also had an eagle's face. (**Ezekiel 1:10**)
- But if not, let it become known to you, O king, that your gods are not the ones we are serving, and the image of gold that you have set up we will not worship. (**Daniel 3:18**)
- And the first living creature is like a lion, and the second living creature is like a young bull, and the third living creature has a face like a mans, and the fourth living creature is like a flying eagle. (**Revelation 4:7**)
- And this is how I saw the horses in the vision, and those seated on them, they had fire-red and hyacinth-blue and sulphur-yellow breastplates, and the heads of the horses were as heads of lions, and out of their mouths fire and smoke and sulphur issued forth. (**Revelation 9:17**)
