- One with a perverse heart is fabricating something bad all the time so as to send out **contentions**.
- Perverseness is in his heart. He is fabricating something bad all the time. He keeps sending out merely **contentions**. (**Proverbs 6:14**)
- Yehowah hates anyone sending forth **contentions** among brothers.
- A false witness that launches forth lies, and anyone sending forth **contentions** among brothers. (**Proverbs 6:19**)
- Hatred only stirs up **contentions** but love covers over even all transgressions.
- Hatred is what stirs up **contentions**, but love covers over even all transgressions. (**Proverbs 10:12**)
- The lot or **Urim and Thummin**, which was the nation's way of asking Yehowah a question put **contentions** to rest.
- The lot puts even **contentions** to rest, and it separates even the mighty from one another. (**Proverbs 18:18**)

- Paul upon arriving in person in Corinth did not want to see **contentions** among his brothers.
- For I am afraid that somehow, when I arrive, I may find you not as I could wish and I may prove to be to you not as you could wish, but, instead, there should somehow be strife, jealousy, cases of anger, **contentions**, backbitings, whisperings, cases of being puffed up, disorders.
