

~FAILED (86)

[English, unsuccessful, botched, disastrous, futile, abortive, Opposite of, successful]

- Joshua and others counseled Israel that not one word out of all of Yehowah's good promises **failed** to come true.
- Not a promise **failed** out of all the good promise that Yehowah had made to the house of Israel. It all came true. (**Joshua 21:45**)
- Now, look! I am going today in the way of all the earth, and you well know with all your hearts and with all your souls that not one word out of all the good words that Yehowah your God has spoken to you has **failed**. They have all come true for you. Not one word of them has failed. (**Joshua 23:14**)
- Blessed be Yehowah, who has given a resting-place to his people Israel according to all that he has promised. There has not **failed** one word of all his good promise that he has promised by means of Moses his servant. (**1 Kings 8:56**)
- Job bemoaned that his kidneys had **failed** deep within him.
- Whom even I shall behold for myself, and whom my very eyes will certainly see, but not some stranger. My kidneys have **failed** deep within me. (**Job 19:27**)
- The Psalmist called out to Yehowah for help saying that his eyes failed, likely in sleep, while waiting for his God to answer.
- I have become tired by my calling out, my throat has become hoarse. My eyes have **failed** while waiting for my God. (**Psalms 69:3**)
- The Psalmist trusted in his rock Yehowah, for he had seen how his own organism and heart had failed within himself.
- My organism and my heart have **failed**. God is the rock of my heart and my share to time indefinite. (**Psalms 73:26**)
- Jeremiah foretold a desolation of the Promised Land so severe that the very eyes of animals would fail from lack of food.

- And the zebras themselves have stood still upon the bare hills. They have snuffed up the wind like the jackals. Their eyes have **failed** because there is no vegetation. (**Jeremiah 14:6**)
- During Jesus' death the sunlight **failed** at around noon till three o'clock in the afternoon.
- Because the sunlight **failed**, then the curtain of the sanctuary was rent down the middle. (**Luke 23:45**)
- Paul shows that it is not as if God's word had **failed** for he says, not all who spring from Israel are really Israel.
- However, it is not as though the word of God had **failed**. For not all who spring from Israel are really Israel. (**Romans 9:6**)
- As one of his maledictions against unfaithful Israel Yehowah promised to give his disobedient people a trembling heart and a **failing** of the eyes and despair of soul.
- And among those nations you will have no ease, nor will there prove to be any resting-place for the sole of your foot, and Yehowah will indeed give you there a trembling heart and a failing of the eyes and despair of soul. (**Deuteronomy 28:65**)
- The Psalmist prays to Yehowah not to leave him just when he is getting old and his own power is **failing**.
- Do not throw me away in the time of old age, just when my power is failing, do not leave me. (**Psalms 71:9**)
- Paul shows that love never fails and therefore it is superior to prophesying, tongues and all knowledge.
- Love never fails. But whether there are gifts of prophesying, they will be done away with. Whether there are tongues, they will cease. Whether there is knowledge, it will be done away with. (**1 Corinthians 13:8**)
