

## ~FUGITIVENESS, LAND OF (25)

[Hebrew, *nudh*, fugitive]

- A land east of Eden, in which the condemned murderer Cain took up residence.
- With that Cain went away from the face of Yehowah and took up residence in the **land of Fugitiveness** to the east of Eden. (**Genesis 4:16**)
- The Hebrew word *nohdh*, **fugitiveness**, is derived from the root word *nudh*, a form of which is rendered fugitive in;
- When you cultivate the ground, it will not give you back its power. A wanderer and a **fugitive** you will become in the earth. (**Genesis 4:12**)
- Here you are actually driving me this day from off the surface of the ground, and from your face I shall be concealed, and I must become a wanderer and **fugitive** on the earth, and it is certain that anyone finding me will kill me. (**Genesis 4:14**)
- The location of the land is unknown.
