

~GITTITH (17)
(Git'tith)

- **A musical expression of uncertain meaning, appearing in the superscriptions of (Psalms Chapters 8,81,84).**
- **The term seems to be derived from the Hebrew word *gath*, which is also the name of a town located on the border of Judah and Philistia.**
- **Some have suggested that Gittith denotes a tune associated with vintage songs, since *gath* refers to a winepress.**
- **The *Greek Septuagint* and the *Latin Vulgate*, therefore, render **Gittith** as winepresses.**
